'RAISE THE ROOF FOR ROGER' WEEK COMING IN JANUARY 2005

A line-up including Hall of Fame coach, Scotty Bowman, NHL alumni and corporate support, eagerly joined the Ottawa Senators Foundation for Raise the Roof for Roger', from Monday, January 10 to Saturday, January 15, to commemorate the work of Roger Neilson and raise funds for Roger's House - pediatric palliative care facility set to serve the National Capital Region and Western Quebec in 2005.

The events for the week include:

Monday, Breakfast launch with Scotty Bowman at the Corel Centre and live on Sports Radio 1200 THE TEAM;

Tuesday, Thank Your Coach Day;

Thursday, Roger's Crazy Tie Day;

Friday, Esso 3-on-3 Hockey Classic at the Corel Centre; and Saturday, Spartacat's Kids Skate with Senators Alumni and the OutCare Foundation Celebration Telethon on CJOHTV and simulcast on TEAM 1200.

'Raise the Roof for Roger' events start early on Monday, January 10 at 5:30 a.m. with a live morning show broadcasting from the Corel Centre at the breakfast launch, featuring keynote speaker Scotty Bowman.
