DETAILS

Date: Saturday, January 27, 2018 (weather permitting)

Place: Windham Mountain, Windham, New York

Time: Drop off is at 6:15AM at Holdrum Middle School. The bus leaves promptly from the Holdrum parking lot at 6:30AM and is anticipated to return by approximately 6:30PM.

Cost: \$115 – includes bus transportation, lift ticket, movies, bagels for breakfast, and snacks for the return trip. *Please make checks out to River Vale PTA.*

Lessons: Available at additional charge of \$28.00 per session - 2 sessions available per day.

Deadline for submission: Monday, January 22, 2018

Space is limited and is first come, first served. Once we have received your child's completed PERMISSION SLIP and CONTRACT FOR CODE OF CONDUCT, we will send you a confirmation. If you do not receive it within 3 days of submission, please contact me via email at marcyb730@gmail.com.

TO BRING

Equipment*, proper clothing, and money for lunch at the lodge or a brown bag lunch.

* Skis and poles, or snowboard

Helmet and goggles

Ski/Snowboard boots

Wrist guards for snowboarders

Note: All participants must bring their own equipment. Renting onsite is not feasible. You can rent equipment in advance. We are arranging a 10% discount for Holdrum Ski & Snowboard Club rentals through Mt. Everest in Westwood. Please let us know if your child will be renting from Mt. Everest, and we will have his/her name added to a membership list that we will provide to the store. *Please make sure your children can identify their equipment. Mix-ups on the mountain can easily occur, and we especially want to make sure children return home with all their own equipment.*

CHAPERONES

We will have at least one adult per 8 children on the mountain. Please contact us if you are interested in chaperoning either in the lodge or on the mountain. You will be notified if your services are needed once we have received all the registration forms.

SAFETY

It is strongly recommended that inexperienced skiers and snowboarders take both morning and afternoon lessons at the mountain to progress faster and be able to fully enjoy the sport. Group lessons are available and last approximately 1 hour 45 minutes each.

Skiing and snowboarding can be hazardous sports. **Helmets are required to participate.** Wrist guards are highly recommended for snowboarders.

INSURANCE AND EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION

We must have your child's completed health insurance information and your credit card information (with expiration date and signature) *on page 3 of this form*. Please be sure to complete this information accurately. PTA insurance does not cover your child while on Holdrum Ski & Snowboard Club outings.

CANCELLATIONS

If your child cannot attend the trip, please contact me as soon as possible to receive a credit or refund. Due to the cancellation policy of the bus company and food costs, any cancellations made after the registration due date will be charged \$65.00.

On the day of the trip, please notify me early if your child should wake up sick. I will be up by 5:15AM. If your child is not at the bus by departure time, I will call you but cannot excessively delay the trip. Remember to please have your child at the bus by 6:15AM.

CONDUCT

Inappropriate behavior on the day of the trip will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action or forfeiture of future trips. Such behavior includes but is not limited to foul or abusive language, insubordination, food fights, disrespect towards the chaperones or schoolmates, and actions that might compromise the safety of the student or other persons on the bus or mountain. *Please complete the Contract for Code of Conduct on page 4 of this form and have your child complete the student portion.*

Please remind your child to ONLY ski or snowboard on trails marked for his/her level of experience. Green circle = beginner, blue square = intermediate, and black diamond = experienced. Terrain parks are also unsafe for skiers who are not highly experienced on such trails.
