



The seal of the Walnut Youth Leadership Council (YLC) incorporates special significance in each symbol and color. The motto, “Learn, Lead, Serve,” concisely describes the motivating **vigor** behind the members of the YLC. The open textbook represents **learning** and **intellect** while “2013” signifies its founding year. **Leadership** is represented by the larger person being followed by many others. The hammer and anvil represent **service** and **strength** while three golden stars are placed above the symbols to signify the members’ **commitment** to each. The laurel leaves symbolize **honor** and **distinction**. There are exactly 35 leaves in the two branches, since there were 35 students involved during the YLC’s first year of creation. The color blue used throughout the seal stands for **knowledge** and **integrity**, while white conveys **truth**. The gold color in the seal symbolizes the YLC’s overall **prestige** and **excellence**.
