

During the Renaissance, the pictorial arts were split between drawing (disegno) and color (colore), the former corresponding with the compositional and linear distinctions of artists such as Giotto and Michelangelo and the latter with the radiant altarpieces of Titian, Tintoretto, and Veronese. The dominance of disegno was unsettled in the 19th century, first by Eugene Delacroix and later by the Impressionists. By the 20th century, Cubism overcame the antagonism by synthesizing the oppositions between color vs. contour; figure vs. ground; light vs. shadow. There were further interrelated developments between line and abstraction during the 20th century: the expressive mark and the abstracted representation of space. In the post-war era, other elements and techniques —pop culture, illustration, cinema, erasure — emerged through artists such as William Kentridge and Raymond Pettibon.

The artists in this show work within, amend, and advance this history. There are two-dimensional works of intricate detail, abstracted forms and spatial renderings, and marked sculptures and videos. Other pieces are suffused with humor and unexpectedly tender detail.
