### PG&E – Turkey Distribution



PG&E is dedicated to ensuring the neighborhoods they share with customers are great places to live and work. Every year, PG&E provides more than 1,500 local grants to organizations supporting education, economic and community vitality, the environment and emergency preparedness across Northern and Central California. In 2014, PG&E granted over \$23 million in charitable giving.
