## Philosophy

## Harvest & Production

Hand-picked grapes in 2012 from select vineyards in the European Atlantic west coast, 50 km distance from Lisbon.

## Vinification

Destemming, crushing, fermentation in stainless steel, temperature-controlled tanks. Pressing and aging in tanks.

## Chemical Analysis

Alcohol - 13.5%

Total Acidity - 5.5 g/L

pH - 3.56

Residual Sugar - 3.9 g/L

## Bottling & Consumption

Bottled July 2015 in 75cl capacity bottles with Portuguese cork stoppers. Consume with cow dishes between 2015-2018.

## Tasting Notes

A wine with a ruby color and a red berry fruits aroma like this deserves to partner with a cut of red meat. This wine in the mouth is elegant with good balance and structure. What a passionate pair cow and wine makes!
