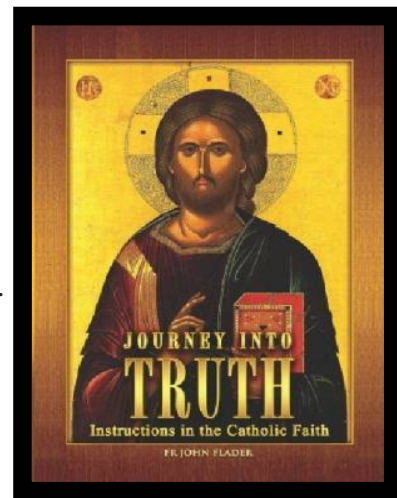


JOURNEY INTO TRUTH

Based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church by Father John Flader

This *Catechism Retreat* is taught by Fr. John Flader who is a priest of Opus Dei. He has a BA from Harvard in the Arts and a Doctorate in Canon Law from the University of Navarre. He explains the principal teachings of the Church in a way anyone can understand and shows how they can be lived in ordinary life.

DATES: **Fall sessions begin Monday, Sept. 18 & Tuesday, Sept. 19, 2017**
We will meet once a week for 12 weeks (with a break for Thanksgiving week) and end on Monday, Dec. 11 and Tuesday, Dec. 12. **Winter/Lent Sessions** begin with both groups meeting on Tuesday, Jan. 2 (due to Monday being New Year's Day) at their regular times. Then they will meet on Mondays and Tuesdays once a week for 12 weeks and end on Monday, March 19 and Tuesday, March 20.

RETREAT COST: **\$15.00 per person or 25.00 per couple or family.** If this is a hardship, please designate on the registration form and we will use donations to pay for your cost.

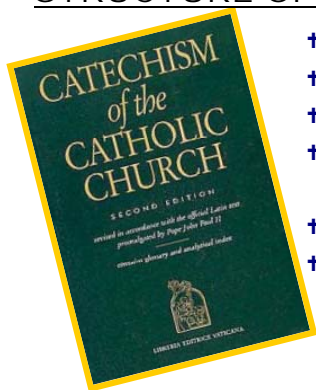
MATERIALS: **You will need a Catechism of the Catholic Church, *Second Edition*** which you must purchase on your own. Extra handouts will be provided.

- + Hymn and Prayer
- + Fr. John Flader teaching video - 30 minutes
- + Small Discussion Groups
- + One of our priests will come to two Sessions during the Fall Sessions and the Winter/Lent Sessions for a Q & A
- + We are working on finding childcare for Monday nights so parents can attend.
- + If you miss a week, you may come one hour early the following week to view the DVD teaching both Mondays and Tuesdays
