Application Process

In order to fill out this application, you must be a middle or high school student with a financial need. The application consists of filling out the questionnaire, writing a short essay, and providing proof of your financial need. Once you have submitted the questionnaire, the essay, and your proof of financial need to info@studentsociety.com, we will contact you with the level of scholarship we are able to offer you.

Maintaining Your Scholarship

There are only 2 components to maintaining your scholarship - consistency and effort. We expect you to schedule appointments with your tutor at least twice per month and *show up to all those appointments on time - no cancellations*. We do not require a minimum grade or GPA, but we do expect to see a consistent effort on your part by trying your best during tutoring sessions and following the advice of your tutors.
