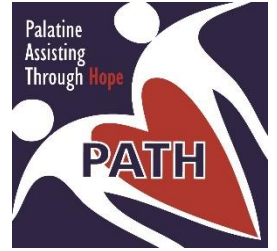


# Donations for November Featured Mission: Palatine Assisting Through Hope (PATH)

## 1. Donating specific items for the Community Clothing Closet:

### New Items

Girls and boys socks for grades K-12

Girls and boys underwear for grades K-12

### New or Gently Used Items

Winter coats for grades K-12

Snow pants for grades K-12

Boots for grades K-12

Gloves for grades K-12

Please drop off items in the marked bin at the Donation Center (near the church nursery) by **Sunday, December 3.**

## 2. Volunteering to sort clothing donations and assist clients at the Community Closet:

A variety of shifts and dates are available to serve at the Community Clothing Closet at Sanborn School, 101 N. Oak St. in Palatine. Sign up for one or multiple shifts at <http://signup.com/go/R4JPLU>. Enter the school through the rear/side entrance on Wood Street.

## 3. Joining PATH's email network:

PATH has an email network of potential donors who can respond when PATH is notified of a family in crisis. Needed items might include: food, clothing, household goods, and/or a monetary donation. PATH notifies the email network for each case, and donors can respond if they are able to assist with any of the needed items.
