Event Overview

You're invited to participate in and sponsor a unique series of events that engages our community, inspires entrepreneurship and solves a very real environmental challenge right here in Austin.

Entrepreneurs are used to pitching their business idea to potential investors, co-founders, and customers. In the [Re]verse Pitch Competition, the tables are turned. Local and national businesses have a market problem they need to solve: valuable raw materials are leaving the business as waste, but could be transformed into the foundation of new social enterprises. In solving this market need, these social businesses will address critical zero waste and economic development challenges in our community.

5-6 corporations and institutions will pitch their byproduct materials as business opportunities to entrepreneurs and enterprising non-profits. Then, over a series of weeks, competitors will be chosen to work with these material suppliers and mentors to solidify a business plan. The competition will culminate in a final event where competitors present their business plans to judges for a chance to win Innovation Prizes to seed their new venture.

Why Sponsor?

Please note that entities with current City contracts, pending or anticipated regulatory or legal matters with the City, or that are bidding or anticipate bidding on contracts within the next year will not be eligible to sponsor due to conflicts of interest.

Innovation Prize Sponsorship Opportunities

The City of Austin is seeking to supplement the City's cash Innovation Prize with in-kind services that will support the new start-up(s) or expanding company/ies that win the [Re]Verse Pitch Competition. Our goal is to offer both a grand prize and a 2nd place prize to competitors.

We are especially seeking donations of:

- Co-working space rental
- Storage space rental
- Legal services

- Accounting services
- Counseling services
- Transportation (i.e. truck rental)
- Software subscriptions
- Relevant memberships

But feel free to surprise us with an in-kind prize not on this list!

Innovation Prize Sponsorship Logistics

All sponsorships will be reviewed for approval to ensure no conflicts of interest and alignment with the event mission. Sponsorships will be paid directly to the winning team determined by the judges and by the voting members of the public at the December 6, 2016 event. Sponsors will be expected to sign an agreement in order to finalize involvement in this event. Provision of the in-kind item will be due upon successful completion by the winner of the terms of the prize winner agreement (or as soon as possible if the service is only offered periodically, i.e. classes). The item or service will be provided directly to the prize winner, not to the City of Austin.

Fund Your Own Prize Option

In addition to sponsoring the main Innovation Prize, organizations are invited to propose their own in-kind prize and criteria for consideration by the project team. Example may include prizes for the best idea for a specific material or the idea that best advances a goal of the organization or company.

Fund Your Own Prize Sponsorship Logistics

All sponsorships will be reviewed for approval to ensure no conflicts of interest and alignment with the event mission. The Sponsor will need to identify criteria for review and approval by the project team and provide a judge to select the prize recipient. Sponsors will be expected to sign an agreement in order to finalize involvement in this event. Provision of the in-kind item will be due upon successful completion by the winner of the terms of the prize winner agreement (or as soon as possible if the service is only offered periodically, i.e. classes). The item or service will be provided directly to the prize winner, not to the City of Austin.

In-Kind Event Cost Sponsorship Opportunities

In addition to prize sponsorship opportunities, there may be opportunities to support the [Re]Verse Pitch Competition event through providing in-kind event-related services such as food, beverages, banner or signage printing, etc. In-kind event sponsors will be recognized based on the equivalent cash value of the item or service donated as outlined below. All sponsorships will be reviewed for approval to ensure no conflicts of interest and alignment with the event mission.

Sponsorship Recognition

The sponsorship level will reflect the value of the in-kind service offered to the winner. For example, a sponsor offering a service that normally costs \$275 would be recognized as a Bronze sponsor.
