1. When the Queen of Sheba observes Solomon's achievements in 1 Kings 10:6-9, what might she be referring to?

2. Read her words again . . . slowly this time. What do you find surprising? Why?

3. What is the indictment against Solomon in the text of Kings?

4. What is the conclusion to Solomon's story as suggested by the book of Ecclesiastes?

5. Brueggemann has suggested that the failure of Solomon may be measured in many ways. One way is his inability to keep "wisdom, might, and wealth" in balance with "love, justice, and righteousness" (See his *Truth Speaks to Power*, Westminster, 2013). How does this challenge play out in the life of the Church today?
