Our **Undeclared EOD Bike Ride** held Columbus Day weekend hosts cyclists of all ability levels who will make the 150-mile trek (2-day) or 65-mile trek (1-day) through San Diego & Orange Counties. These rides benefit the EOD Warrior Foundation – funding and assisting military EOD families caring for their loved ones.

EOD is Explosive Ordnance Disposal, the military's bomb squad. The Undeclared EOD Bike Ride began in 2009, the year that was the most devastating to the EOD community in injuries and lives lost. Rehabilitating EOD Technicians take part in the event, some riding on the prosthetic "cycling legs" alongside civilian and military riders. Since 2009, this event has raised \$1.52 Million for EODWF.
