

## Rise and Shine Timeline

### **1918-1919**

The influenza or flu pandemic, the deadliest in modern history, infected an estimated 500 million people worldwide—about one-third of the planet's population at the time—and killed an estimated 20 million to 50 million victims.

### **August 26, 1920**

19th Amendment to the United States Constitution, which grants women the right to vote, becomes law. Washington women had won the vote in 1910, after which Washington suffragists had helped with the national campaign to amend the constitution so that all American women could vote.

### **June 2, 1924**

Indian Citizenship Act makes all Native Americans U.S. citizens

### **September 14, 1925**

Centralia Junior College holds its first day of classes.

### **March 9, 1926**

Seattle elects Bertha K. Landes as first woman mayor of a major American city.

### **1927**

Charles Lindbergh lands the *Spirit of St. Louis* in Seattle and in Spokane.

### **October 29, 1929**

Stock market crash, called Black Tuesday, hits.

### **August 14, 1936**

University of Washington rowing crew wins the Olympic Gold Medal.

### **November 7, 1940**

Tacoma Narrows Bridge collapses.
