Souper Bowl of Caring is youth across the nation working to fight hunger and poverty in their communities around the time of the Super Bowl football game each year. On Super Bowl Sunday, young people take up a collection (many use a soup pot), asking for one dollar or one item of food for people in need.



Souper Bowl of Caring groups give 100% of the donation (whether money or cans) directly to a local hunger relief charity of the group's choice.

In 2014, more than 10,000 groups collected more than \$8 million in dollars and food for local hunger relief charities. That's a total of more than \$100 million collected since the movement began in 1990!

This Sunday, February 7, at the conclusion of the worship service, Second's Youth will be holding soup pots and cans at the Sanctuary exits in which you are encouraged to donate money to the Souper Bowl of Caring. Second Youth's goal is to raise \$500 which Second's Missions Committee has earmarked for Second's Fish Pantry Designated Fund.

But the Souper Bowl of Caring at Second doesn't stop there!

You are also encouraged to bring a regular size can of a vegetable or soup to place as a centerpiece design on your table at the Potluck Lunch that will happen in the Fellowship Hall immediately following the worship service. All canned goods donated will go directly to Second's Fish Pantry ministry. The goal is for each person to bring one can.
