Day 1 June 14, Sunday: Depart USA

Depart Los Angeles International Airport via Lufthansa for our overseas journey to Prague, Czech Republic. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served in flight. (B)

Day 2 June 15, Monday: Arrive in Prague

Arrive at Prague International Airport, proceed through passport control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our motor coach and we will be on our way to Prague, the "City of 100 Spires." Check-in at our hotel before enjoying the remainder of the day at leisure. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Prague. (B,D)

Day 3 June 16, Tuesday: Highlight Tour of Prague | Concert Presentation at St. Nicholas | Gala Dinner

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Today will be spent getting acquainted with the magnificent city of Prague, which is undoubtedly one of the most picturesque cities in the world. The city was spared from destruction during World War II and still contains beautiful examples of ancient architecture. Enjoy a guided tour of Prague, including the castle district (Hradčany). Visit St. Vitus' Cathedral, which is used for the inauguration of presidents and houses the tomb of St. Wenceslas and former rulers of the Czech Kingdom. **Celebrate Mass at St. Vitus Cathedral.** After Mass, we'll pass by the Basilica of St. George to visit Prague Castle. Then, stroll through Mala Strana with its amazing architectural buildings. Independent lunch.

2:00 p.m. rehearsal at the Church of St. Nicholas on the Square.

3:00 p.m. concert presented by the combined choirs.

After the concert, visit the Old Town Square. See the famous astronomical clock that comes alive when the hour strikes and the twelve disciples appear to bless the crowd. We'll also have the chance to visit the Church of Our Lady before Tyn and walk through the Prague alleyways from Powder Tower to St. Wenceslas Square. Return to our hotel to freshen-up. **This evening, we will be transferred to a popular Czech restaurant for a gala dinner with entertainment.** While dining and tasting the traditional specialties of Czech cuisine, we'll watch an enjoyable program featuring folk music and dances.

Overnight at our hotel in Prague. (B,D)

Day 4 June 17, Wednesday: Old Town of Prague | Vienna

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Carmelite Church of Our Lady of Victorious in the Lesser Quarter, where the famous statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague is preserved and venerated. **Celebrate Mass at the shrine, sung by the combined choirs.** Then, we'll continue to visit the beautiful, statue-lined Charles Bridge and the Old Town, considered one of the best-preserved old cities in Europe. Independent lunch.

This afternoon, continue to Vienna, the Music Capital of the World! Vienna is the city of Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, and Strauss.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (B,D)

Day 5 June 18, Thursday: Concert Presentation at St. Stephen's Cathedral

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, begin our day with a visit to St. Stephen's Cathedral, Austria's most eminent Gothic edifice that houses a wealth of art treasures. The architectural history begins in the 12th century, and the oldest remaining parts date from the 13th century: the Giant Gate (Riesentor) and the Towers of the Heathens (Heidentürme), both Romanesque in style. The 448-foot South Tower (Südturm) was completed in 1433. The Viennese have given it the nickname Steffl, which also denotes the whole cathedral. During the 18th century, the cathedral was decorated with Baroque altarpieces. The panel of the main altar shows the stoning of its namesake St. Stephen, the first martyr of Christendom. **Celebrate Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral.**

12:00 to 12:40 p.m.: Rehearsal at Leo Hall.

12:45 to 1:15 p.m.: Concert presentation at St. Stephen's Cathedral by the combined choirs.

Independent lunch Viennese-style. We recommend you try the famous Café Demel, Café Hofburg, or Café Balthasar, all within reach.

The afternoon is free to explore Vienna on your own. Perhaps you'll choose to tour Mozart House and Museum, a three-story museum where Mozart lived from 1784 to 1787. You might visit the House of Music, a hands-on museum nestled between St. Stephen's Cathedral and the Vienna State Opera. Interactive installations allow you to conduct the Vienna Philharmonic from a virtual conductor's podium, and the musicians on the screen will tell you if you are up to par.

Independent dinner. Overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (B)

Day 6 June 19, Friday: Highlight Tour of Vienna | Schönbrunn Palace | Concert Presentation at Peterskirche

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **Begin our day with Mass at the Capuchin Church, sung by the combined choirs.** After Mass, begin our orientation tour of Vienna. Pass by the Hofburg Palace, winter residence of the Habsburg emperors; the Capuchin Church containing the imperial vaults; St. Charles' Church, a splendid example of late Baroque architecture; and the Belvedere Palace, former residence of Prince Eugene of Savoy. Drive around the Ring, one of the most magnificent boulevards in the world, passing by the Vienna Opera, the House of Parliament, City Hall, and the Burgtheater. Continue on to visit Schönbrunn Palace, the summer residence of the Habsburgs. The castle was built by Ferdinand II in 1637. It came into its full grandiose incarnation during the reign of Maria Theresa, when she added the massive mirrors, frescoed ceilings, and gigantic crystal chandeliers. Independent lunch.

2:15 - 2:55 p.m.: Rehearsal at Peterskirche.

3:00 - 3:10 p.m.: Organ recital (by the church organist)

3:10 - 3:40 p.m.: Concert presentation by the combined choirs.

3:40 - 3:50 p.m.: Organ recital (by the church organist)

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Vienna. (B,D)

Day 7 June 20, Saturday: Florian Abbey | Salzburg

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, depart Vienna for Salzburg. Enjoy magnificent scenery along the Danube River in the Wachau, a region that is the pride of the historic preservation movement in Austria. Late morning we'll arrive in historic Linz, in upper Austria. Independent lunch in Linz.

A tour of the Abbey of St. Florian. The largest abbey in upper Austria, it is a renowned cultural center and has been occupied since the eleventh century by Canons of St. Augustine. The present buildings are in the purest Baroque style. The monastery was entirely rebuilt from 1686 to 1751—first under the initial direction of Carlo Antonio Carlone, then finished by Jakob Prandtauer. We will have the opportunity to view the famous Bruckner Organ and visit Bruckner's Grave in the abbey crypt. **Celebrate Mass and present a 20-minute concert at the abbey.** Afterward, we'll continue to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River, for a two-night stay. Check-in at our hotel.

Dinner at our hotel. **Choir members only: Choir rehearsal with Prof. Janos Czifra, Director of Music of Salzburg Cathedral, will be scheduled. [Mozart - Credo Missa Brevis in C (KV 220 - Spatzenmesse)].**

Overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B,D)

Day 8 June 21, Sunday: Mass at Salzburg Cathedral | Highlight Tour of Salzburg

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **Morning transfer to the cathedral for warm-up and 10:00 a.m. Sung Mass by the combined choirs together with the Cathedral Choir and Orchestra conducted by Prof. Janos Czifra. [Mozart - Credo Missa Brevis in C, (KV 220 - Spatzenmesse - publisher Bärenreiter)].**

After Mass, there will be a photo opportunity in the Cathedral Square. Independent lunch.

After lunch, we'll embark on a guided tour of Salzburg's sights along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings, including the house where Mozart was born. View Monchsberg, one of Salzburg's five mountains, topped with the fortress Hohensalzburg, which overlooks the city. Built into the side of Monchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Operas. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the dynamic sculpture of the Residenzbrunnen, the largest Baroque fountain north of the Alps. The Residenz building, built in 1596, was once the palace of the Bishops. Nearby stands the cathedral, dating from 1614. Next, visit St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery seen in the film *The Sound of Music* and where most of Mozart's religious works were premiered. Independent dinner.

Overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B)

Day 9 June 22, Monday: Neuschwanstein Castle | Munich

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we'll leave Salzburg to Wieskirche, the impressive Rococo-era Pilgrimage Church of Wies designed in the 1740s. **Celebrate Mass at the Wieskirche.** After Mass, we'll explore King Ludwig's majestic castle, the Cinderella-style fortress Neuschwanstein. This white and dream-like castle was built in 1869 according to sketches of a theatrical decorator, explaining the whimsical atmosphere. Go back in time as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas, the throne rooms and music halls, King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings, and an artificial Grotto that recalls opera themes of his friend, composer Richard Wagner. Independent lunch.

Continue to Munich. We'll have an orientation tour by coach, passing by the town hall and the magnificent Boulevard Feldherrnhalle Ludwigstrasse Siegestor, created by King Ludwig I in the middle of the 19th century. Continue on to the Marienplatz, the world-famous Glockenspiel, and the twin-towered Frauenkirche, the most familiar landmark of old Munich. Check-in at our hotel. **Enjoy dinner at Hofbräuhaus, drinking in German culture and history.**

Overnight at our hotel in Munich. (B,D)

Day 10 June 23, Tuesday: Return to the USA

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning we will be transferred to Munich Airport for our return flight to Los Angeles. Arrive home the same day. (B)

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If a final payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. If you cancel from 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury. Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. We do not refund costs associated with tour services that are not utilized.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation based on availability. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: It is the traveler's responsibility to have a valid passport for international travel. **U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.** Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all required documents are complete and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents, including passports.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes round-trip estimated economy class airfare from Los Angeles. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). If you purchase independent connecting flights, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. **It is important that you do not independently purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed by Peter's Way Tours for travel.**

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The estimated Land Only package cost is \$2,995.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$100 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include any portion of the group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book all segments independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying Peter's Way Tours in writing, up to 100 days prior to date of departure. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the group flight arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). **If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.**

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with special requests. ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on two persons sharing a hotel room with two twin beds and private facilities. Married couples may request a double bed, however, double beds are subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, however, there is no discount for triple occupancy. **Single rooms are limited and may be requested at time of booking. They are sometimes smaller than twin rooms and may be separated from the room block. If confirmed, an additional charge of \$750.00 will apply.** We will make every effort to accommodate roommate requests, but we cannot guarantee double occupancy. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast daily plus six (6) dinners, including a gala dinner with entertainment in Prague and a farewell dinner at Hofbräuhaus in Munich.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; and €1.50 Euro per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for the wait staff after each meal and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
