Primarily a ministry of availability, Steve and Annette share the love of God through pastoral care, social work, crisis management, advocacy, and consulting to refugees from Burma and those who seek to serve them. CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates)

The mission of CASA is to advance the best interests of abused, neglected and dependent children in the Mercer/Boyle County Family Court system through the training of volunteers who serve as Court Appointed Special Advocates working with children, the family and the court.

Eliza Broadus: Kentucky State Missions



Cooperative Baptist Fellowship

We are a Christian Network that helps people put their faith to practice through ministry efforts, global missions and a broad community of support. CBF engages in God's mission with and among the most neglected and least evangelized people on earth. CBF Global Missions mobilizes field personnel working in over 30 countries and regions collaborating with partners worldwide. Based in Atlanta, CBF partners with 15 theological schools, 18 autonomous state and regional organizations and more than 150 ministry organizations worldwide. The Cooperative Baptist Fellowship supports more than 160 field personnel around the world. They are serving in remote villages, large cities, in the United States and in countries with little access to the gospel.

Cooperative Baptist Fellowship Kentucky

Cooperative Baptist Fellowship Kentucky is a fellowship of churches and individuals who are committed to the Great Commission of Jesus Christ. The mission is three-fold: 1) to help churches partner with one another and with other organizations that share a similar philosophy and goal; 2) to provide resources for churches and individuals as they do their work; and 3) to encourage involvement in missions and ministries in local communities, throughout the state, and globally (Such as Empower West Louisville, Morocco Partnership, and Mountain Hope). LABC has worked closely with CBF Kentucky in the partnership with Nada in Eastern Kentucky and the Evangelical Protestant Church of Morocco.

Baptist Seminary of Kentucky

The purpose of Baptist Seminary of Kentucky (BSK) is to prepare men and women sensing God's leadership for life and ministry in faithful witness to Jesus Christ in the church and the world. BSK is accredited by the Commission on Accrediting of the Association of Theological Schools in the United States and Canada (ATS). Located on the campus of Georgetown College, in Georgetown, KY, BSK offers a Master of Divinity degree designed to prepare students for Christian ministry in a local church or in a wide variety of other contexts.

Salvation Army

The mission of Salvation Army is to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in his name without discrimination. Among other things, LABC gifts will help provide staffing, equipment, supplies and maintenance of the Youth Center. The Youth Center provides a gym and programming for local children and teens. A portion of LABC gifts will go for social services, which provides financial assistance for individuals and families in crisis. Some will be used by LABC to provide food for the Salvation Army Food Bank.

Soup's On Us

"Soup's On Us" is a weekend food ministry sponsored by Lexington Avenue Baptist, Saints Peter and Paul Catholic, First Christian, and the Presbyterian Church of Danville. On one Saturday per month we prepare and deliver meals.

Morocco & Haiti (Global Ministries)

Partnership with the Evangelical Protestant Church in Rabat, Morocco and work with African migrants, and other global ministries. With the church in Morocco, we share Common Worship Services, have visited Morocco and received visitors from our partner church. \$1200 goes to pay a stipend for the associate pastor of the church. Some funds will go to support ministry with African migrants who end up in Morocco after fleeing war, famine, and poverty in Sub-Saharan Africa. Half of the Global Ministries Offering will go to Haiti Missions.

Mountain Hope (Nada)

Mountain Hope includes mission trips and special projects in Nada. Part of this gift may be used to help support a missionary in Nada. Nada is a small impoverished community in the mountains of Eastern Kentucky. Mountain Hope is the Kentucky affiliate of Together for Hope, a ministry with the twenty poorest counties in the United States. Two of these counties are in Kentucky—Owsley and McCreary.

Benevolence

Helps people (mostly from Danville/Boyle County area) with food, housing, utilities and other expenses in times of crisis.

Mission Projects

Mission projects include neighborhood ministry, Fall Festival, mission trips, evangelism, outreach, and more.

Youth Mission Trips/Projects

Our youth participate in a variety of mission trips and projects near and far, such as Passport Camp, Nada mission trips, Operation Christmas Child, Salvation Army, and more.

Unanticipated Mission Needs

We are sometimes able to support church members and other mission groups with special mission trips and projects and to address unanticipated mission needs that arise during the year.

Sunrise Children's Services

Sunrise Children's Services provides care and hope for hurting families and children through Christ-centered ministries. Sunrise is a home for children who have been abused and neglected — children whose lives have been scarred by unspeakable physical, sexual, and emotional abuse — and who have been removed from their homes. Our goal is to provide a place of refuge, of hope, of love, and of healing to these children whose lives have been devastated. For these children, Sunrise is a place where they can begin to feel safe, a place where they encounter adults who give unconditional love, a place where they can begin to learn that the world can be a good place.

Clear Creek Baptist College

Clear Creek Baptist Bible College, Pineville, Kentucky exists to provide theological preparation for adults called of God to Christian service. Located in Eastern Kentucky, Clear Creek provides theological training for those who might not ordinarily have the opportunity.

Haven Care Center (Pregnancy Resource)

We support Haven Care through the Bottles of Blessings annual offering. Haven is a non-profit organization, faith-based reaching out to our community placing Christ in the Center. Our goal is for others to desire our "Safe Haven." Our mission is to offer FREE services, that are confidential, giving unconditional love, care, and support for those facing unplanned pregnancies through empowerment and education. We offer the following services: free self-administered pregnancy tests, onsite ultrasound for those who may be abortion vulnerable, peer counseling, education in the schools, adoption referrals, post abortion support, daily devotion/bible studies, parenting classes, and a voucher system in place for pregnancy needs.
