

#### **AQG Guild Meeting Minutes July 9, 2018**

The Guild meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Vice President Sherry Williams.

Minutes: Janice Watson moved to approve the May minutes as published and Pat Crawford seconded the motion. The vote was passed to accept minutes as published.

**Treasure's Report:** Treasurer Mary Jane Beard provided report regarding June's finances. Treasure report has been posted on-line.

She also has kits available for members. 27 quilts have been donated thus far. Anyone that donates will be given a ticket, and there will be a drawing at the end of the year for a prize.

Any remaining donation quilts from juvenile fabric unsuitable for an adult are welcome and can be donated to The Call foster care program.
