






Ori to fold + gami paper

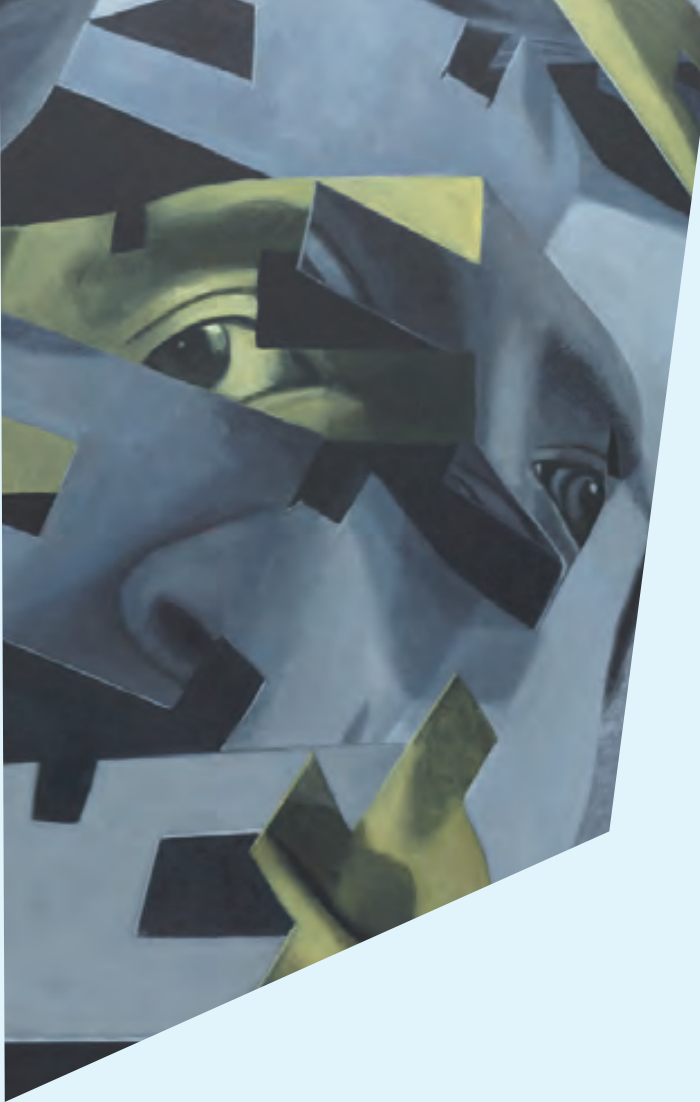
Origami is similar to kirigami but uses folding and no cutting to create the final object.

Kiri to cut + gami paper

Kirigami is the Japanese art of creating a three dimensional object from a flat piece of paper. In ancient times, kirigami was used in Buddhist temples to create sacred offerings to the gods.¹

In these paintings, flat photographs are folded and cut using kirigami and origami techniques. The folds in the paper show and hide different parts of the face, suggesting both struggle and determination.

The women are figures important to the American women's and civil rights movements, or, in the yellow series, famous artists.

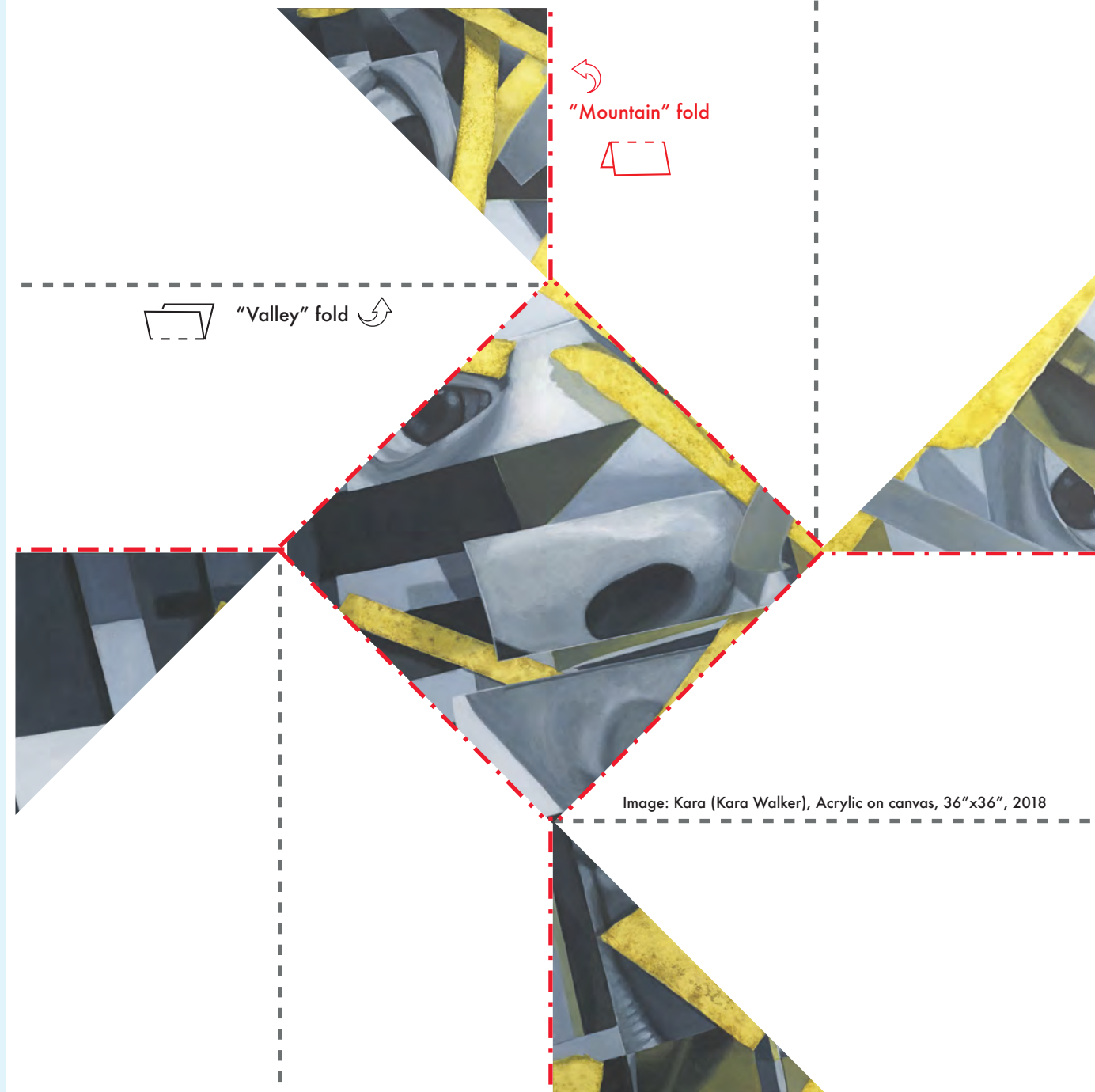

Make a Twist Fold

Cut or fold/tear out **white square**. Dashed lines are **valley folds** (fold down) and red dot-dashed lines are **mountain folds** (fold up). Collapse the model either along all fold lines at once or progressively.
