MARSANNE, ROUSSANNE AND VIOGNIER

These are the white grapes of the Rhone Valley. Tellurian in Heathcote have really captured the beauty of these often forgotten grapes.

Tellurian, meaning 'of the earth', vineyard is farmed organic, and Tellurian is in transition for organic certification. Winemaker Tobias Ansted's philosophy is to craft each wine with minimal intervention, to capture the natural essence of site and variety in wines of intensity and finesse. Tobias enhanced his love of Rhone Valley whites after spending time with Yves Cuilleron in Condrieu, the home of Viognier and during his time there honed his sense of balance between flavour, weight, texture and structure.

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SAUVIGNON BLANC & SEMILLON

CHARDONNAY

SHIRAZ

HEAD Wines was started in 2006 by Alex Head. Alex has long been interested in 'Old-World' wines and their symbiosis with all things culinary; particularly Shiraz from an appellation in France's Northern Rhone Valley called Cote Rotie (roasted slope). A great legend states that in the Middle Ages a Seigneur of Ampuis called 'Count Maugiron' owned the steeply terraced hills of Cote Rotie. He was also blessed with two beautiful daughters, one a blonde and the other a brunette. The Southern slope of the Cote made a softer, rounded more elegant wine which delighted its drinkers with perfume and femininity. Here, the soil and wines showed colour and character of his blonde daughter. On the other hand The Northern slope produced an intense wine with dark fruits and tannin that required age to show its true potential. Here, the soil and wine showed colour and character of his brunette daughter. When Count Maugiron finally retired he passed on the two Cotes to his daughters and to this day, they are still referred to as the 'Cote Blonde' and 'Cote Brune'.

CABERNET, CABERNET FRANC AND MERLOT

A grape which has lost sex appeal over the years. Virginia, the head wine maker at Vasse Felix is on a crusade to bring it back and we think she is doing a brilliant job of it. Cabernet Sauvignon is a small berry with a thick skin and can quit a structured and tannic wine on its own. A dash of Merlot, Malbec, Petit Verdot can soften its edges and give it plushness. Cabernet can be a wine of power and generosity, concentration and structure, with a little touch of elegance.
