

Goose Pond Sanctuary's BIRD SPECIES LIST

Updated February 2021

Birds are at the heart of our work. Madison Audubon's Goose Pond Sanctuary was established in 1968, originally to protect the waterfowl that flocked to the resource-rich prairie pothole for which the sanctuary is named. Since then, we have expanded our work and vision to include conservation of many species of birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, invertebrates, and plants.

Laura Erickson (former Madison Audubon board member) took the lead on creating the first Goose Pond Sanctuary bird checklist in 1978, with assistance from Madison Audubon and Wisconsin Society for Ornithology members and records. They documented a stunning 223 species. To celebrate the sanctuary's 50th anniversary in 2018, Mark Martin and Susan Foote-Martin, again with Madison Audubon and WSO members and records, and eBird documentation found 39 new species between 1978 and 2018, and another two species in old records from the 1950s. Habitat restoration at Goose Pond Sanctuary, along with bird conservation done more broadly, have helped increase the number of birds on the checklist to 267. The 2018 and 2020 additions are denoted with an asterisk (*), and 1950s records marked with a double asterisk (**). The checklist nomenclature and sequence follow the 59th supplement of the Checklist of North American Birds published by the American Ornithological Society.
