Hailing from Honolulu, Hawaii, Foreseeable Futures' music bridges the borders of Americana ballads, the heartfelt strains of the indie acoustic genre, and the rhythmic, soaring hooks of pop.

Though Phil Potter (guitar, vocals) and Anna Sachs (vocals, harmonica, melodica) have spent almost their entire lives involved in music, their two years together as a band so far have culminated in Foreseeable Futures' full-length debut album, released in Winter 2015.
