# Authority & Requirements

## Disposal Authority

The Department of Energy has authority to donate surplus personal property to non-Federal recipients involved in economic redevelopment, such as Community Reuse Organizations (CRO's).

## Requirements

DOE Facility has to be a closure site  
or  
DOE Facility is to be reconfigured



# What Is difference?



## Excess Property

Any personal property under the control of a federal agency that is no longer required for that agency's needs or mission, as determined by the agency head or designee.

Title 41 Code of Federal Regulation 102-36.40



## Surplus Property

Excess personal property no longer required by the Federal agencies as determined by GSA.

Title 41 Code of Federal Regulation 102-36.40

# Steps of Property Disposal

## Declared excess

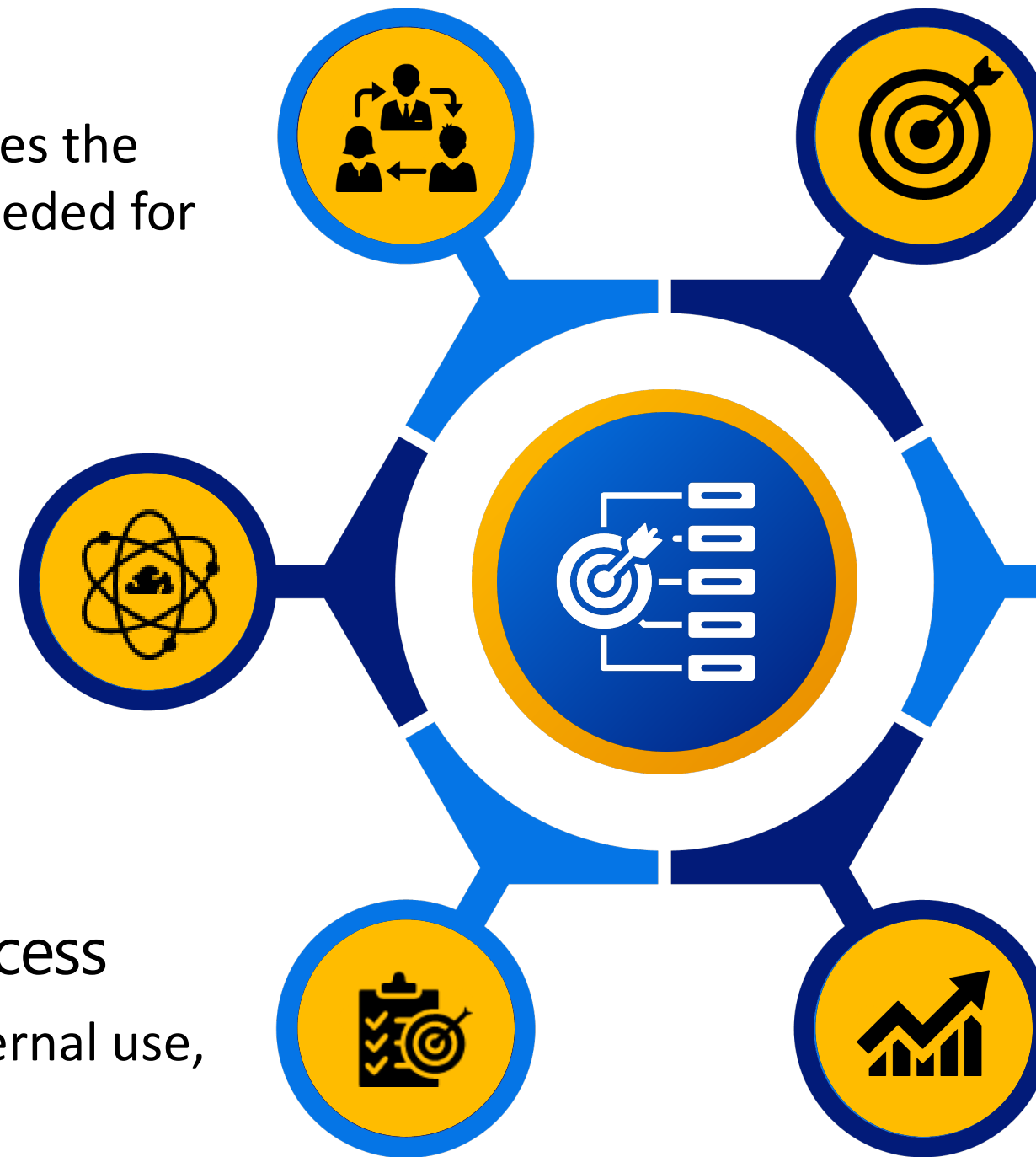
DOE program or facility determines the personal property is no longer needed for its intended purpose.

## DOE Screening Process

The personal property is internally screened throughout DOE for 12 days.

## Federal Screening Process

If property is not selected for internal use, it will then go through the excess screening process for all federal agencies which typically takes 14-21 days.



## Surplus Screening Process

If property is not selected through the federal excess screening process, it is then determined to be surplus personal property by the General Service (GSA) Administration and can be donated to eligible recipients.

## State Agency for Surplus Property (SASP)

The SASP is the agency designated under State law to receive Federal surplus personal property for distribution to eligible recipients within the State as provided for in 40 U.S.C. 549. (41 CFR 102-37)

## CRO's

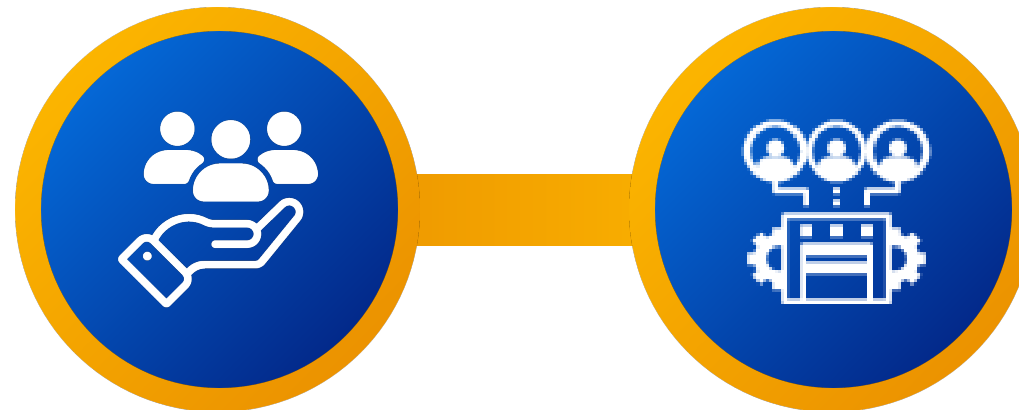
Donees should submit their requests for property directly to the appropriate SASP. SASP then allocates the property to the greatest need of the state.

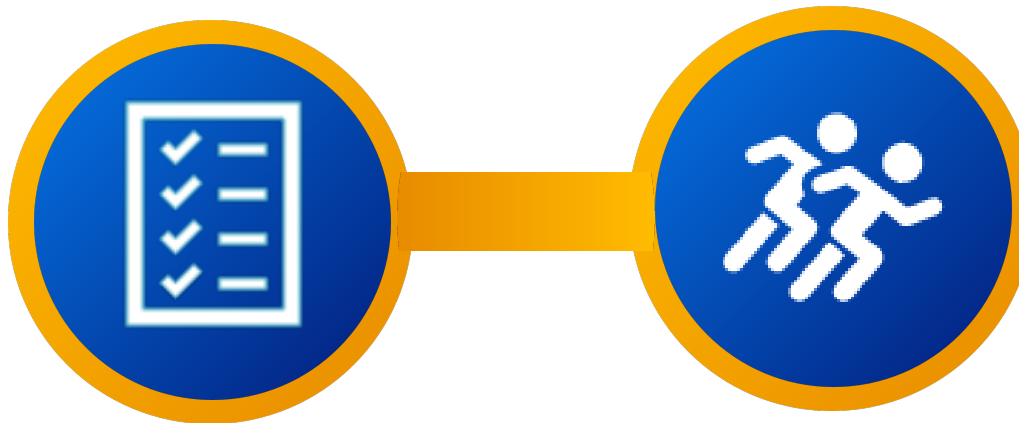

GSA uses the [National Distribution Target Report](#) in allocating available surplus property to SASP. The report is based on census figures over a three-year period and reflects each state agency's individual "piece of the surplus property pie."
