Aromas of citrus and apple lead to an elegant, mouthwatering palate.

Crémant De Bourgogne Rosé, Parigot, France NV \$63  
100% pinot noir - fresh pink berries with a refreshing finish.

Ployez-Jacquemart, Extra Quality Brut, Reims NV \$95  
A bouquet of apple, grilled bread and almond notes both full-bodied and zesty.

Pierre Moncuit, Brut Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru, Les Mesnil-sur-Oger NV \$120  
Baked apple, pastry and spice are infused in a layered, voluptuous finish.

Billecart-Salmon, Brut Reserve, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ NV \$142 750ml / \$294 1.5L  
Pinot Meunier-dominant with flavors of toasted brioche, lemon curd, & evaporating soft bubbles.

Vilmart & Cie Brut 'Grand Cellier,' Reims NV \$163  
A luxury Champagne fermented in antique barrels with aromas of orange blossom, mint, herbs & spice.

Billecart-Salmon Brut Rosé, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ NV \$95 375ml / \$220 750ml / \$418 1.5L  
Elegant hints of strawberry, tangerine, and flowers, with lively pink bubbles.

Macon, Bourcier-Martinot 2014 \$45  
Fresh, unoaked flavors of pear and lemon with a clean mineral zip.

Vire-Clesse, Domaine de Roally, Thévenet 2014 \$65  
Elegant and exotic, with fresh tropical fruit and stoney acidity.

Chablis 1er Cru "Vaucoupin," Domaine Servin 2013 \$69  
Clean and fresh palate with notes of pink grapefruit and lemon, with golden pineapple and brown sugar on the nose.

Pouilly-Fuissé 'Tête De Cru,' Château-Fuissé 2013 \$77  
Ripeness with meyer lemon and honey, creamy mouthfeel with floral and spice notes.

Meursault, Domaine Prieur-Brunet 2013 \$126  
Complex on the palate showing rhubarb, truffles and toasted hazelnut notes.

Meursault 'Clos du Cromin,' Domaine Genot Boulanger 2012 \$130  
Aromas of light citrus with crisp acidity and a lingering toasted oak finish.

Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru Sous Frétille, Domaine Antonin Guyon 2012 \$153  
Fragrant white flowers evolve into honey and spice with harmonious minerality.

Chassagne-Montrachet 'Clos Saint Jean,' Michel Niellon 2004 \$180  
White fruits, fresh lemon peel with a touch of earth delivering full body and great length.

Puligny-Montrachet, Domaine Hubert Bouzereau-Gruère & Filles 2012 \$205  
Expressions of acacia, hazelnut, vanilla and white pepper with great finesse and freshness.

## Loire Whites

Philippe Raimbault, Sancerre Apud Sariaicum 2015 \$59

Fresh grapefruit and green plum mingle with bracing minerality and refined spice on the finish.

Pouilly-Fume, Jonathan Pabiot 2015 \$65

Lemon-lime and yellow plum meet bracing flintiness in this refined classic.

Pouilly-Fumé, Pascal Jolivet, 2015 \$70

Focused citrus and mineral aromas with layered clean, driving acidity.

Vouvray Sec, "Domaine du Clos Naudin," Philippe Foreau 2012 \$74

Dried pineapple, brown sugar, crisp minerality with vibrant acidity; mouth-watering.

Sancerre "La Croix du Roy," Lucien Crochet 2013 \$81

Crisp minerality with fresh lime and grapefruit flavors from a renowned Sancerre producer.

## Italian Whites

Gavi DOCG, Tenuta San Pietro, Piedmont 2015 \$47

A bright, piedmont white with a floral, stony nose, fresh acidity and a lingering finish.

Erbaluce di Caluso "La Torrazza," Ferrando, Piedmont 2013 \$52

Hand harvested with lovely aromatics & flavors of guava, peach and tangerine; a crisp mineral profile.

Kerner, Abbazia di Novacella, Trentino-Alto Adige 2013 \$55

A dry, perfumey wine from the Kerner grape; reminiscent of both Riesling and Gewurztraminer with notes of peach & mango.

Chardonnay, Pomino Benefizio Riserva DOC, Frescobaldi, Tuscany 2014 \$120

A unique Chardonnay with aromas of flowers and tropical fruit, blending with spicy scents and delicate wood notes.

## Other French Whites

Cassis Blanc, Domaine du Bagnol, Provence 2013 \$55

A blend of Marsanne, Clairette and Ugni Blanc, this dry, juicy wine tastes of lychee, white pear, and minerals.

Riesling "Cuvée Albert," Albert Mann, Alsace 2014 \$60

Bouquet of white flowers with juicy peaches and melon; snappy and dry.

Viognier "Les Contours de Deponcins," François Villard, Rhône 2014 \$77

A floral nose that leads to a palate of sweet nectarines and plum.

Côtes du Rhône Blanc, "Les Gendrines," Pierre Gaillard 2014 \$88

Spiced toffee and peach compote mingle with black tea and white flowers, rich and balanced.

Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc, Domaine Bois de Boursan, Rhone 2013 \$95

A blend of Rhone white grapes with exotic aromatics and an unctuous, stony mouthfeel.

## New World Whites

**Chardonnay, Fox Run, Finger Lakes 2015 \$47**

Unoaked upstate New York Chardonnay with notes of apple & nectarine, balanced with citrusy acidity.

**Riesling, Dry, Hermann J. Wiemer, Finger Lakes remove state 2014 \$46**

Fragrant spring blossoms balanced with crisp minerality.

**Hanna, Russian River Valley Chardonnay (2014) \$64**

Creamy lemon curd and roasted nuts with a wisp of tropical fruit and a fresh, lively mouthfeel.

**Sauvignon Blanc, "Equitem," Galerie, Knights Valley 2014 \$75**

Aromas of juicy melon with flavors of orange blossom and passion fruit paired with a complex mouthfeel.

**Chardonnay, "Lindaflor" Bodega Montevejo, Mendoza, Argentina 2013 \$79**

Tropical fruits, apple and buttered toast are balanced with great acidity and a long finish.

**Chardonnay, Chappellet, Napa Valley \$82**

Old World in character showing bright fruit flavors, acidity, minerality and subtle hints of oak.

**Chardonnay, Talley, Arroyo Grande Valley 2012 \$88**

Estate bottled fruit evoking buttered pastry, honey and yellow stone fruits, soft and complex.

**Merry Edwards, Sauvignon Blanc, Russian River Valley \$108**

Smooth and succulent melon, pear and white peach sing with the richness of french barrel age.

**Chardonnay, "3D" Brewer Clifton, Sta Rita Hills 2009 \$116**

Spice-accented aromas of pear, melon, and orange blossom with flavors of lime and ginger.

**Chardonnay, Kistler "Les Noisetiers," Sonoma Coast 2014 \$155**

Full and unctuous with notes of orchard fruit, cream, and vanilla.

**Chardonnay, "The Judge," Kongsgaard, Napa 2008 \$395**

A truly outstanding vintage from a highly-acclaimed producer. Alluring spices with a dense yet lively finish.

## **Rosé Wine**

**Kekfrankos Rozé, Duzsi Tamas, Hungary 2015 \$45**

Bright citrus fruit, tropical lychee tones and a zesty mineral finish.

**Gothic "Telltale," Willamette Valley 2015 \$48 750ml / 2015 \$96 1.5L**

Provence style, bright acidity, notes of lemon meringue and cherry blossom.

**Bandol Rosé, Domiane la Suffrene, Provence, France 2014 \$61**

Fleshy, full-bodied with orange and banana aromas, fresh strawberries and a slightly peppery finish.

**Château Simone "Les Grands Carmes de Simone," Rhone, France 2014 \$90**

Blood orange and bitter plum are complemented by dried flowers and smoky minerality.

## Burgundy Reds

Gamay Noir, Bonnet Rouge, Beaujolais 2013 \$50

A blend of all Cru Beaujolais wines with strawberry notes and lovely aromatics.

St. Amour 'Les Champs Grilles,' Domaine Cheveau 2013 \$51

Juicy Beaujolais that bursts with red berries and freshness.

Hautes Côtes de Nuits 'Les Dames de Vergy,' Domaine Antonin Guyon 2011 \$81

Aromas of blackberries and spice with a creamy texture and long finish.

Givry 1er Cru 'Clos Sainte-Pierre,' Domaine Thenard 2012 \$84

Rustic and rich with spicy kirsch, plum cobbler and strawberry notes that balance with oak and earth.

Auxey-Duresses, Domaine Billard 2013 \$90

An elegant Pinot Noir with notes of red berries and spice with a lingering finish.

Marsannay Rouge 'Les Boivins,' Domaine Coillot Père et Fils 2011 \$104

A melange of black olives and black cherry aromas with lush fruit and gentle oak on the palate.

Beaune '1er Cru Cent Vignes,' Domaine Bitouzet-Prieur 2011 \$111

Firm tannins lead to highly distinct aromatic intensity with wild berries and earth.

Mercurey Rouge, Château de Chamirey 2012 \$128

Soft spices meet intense black fruits expressing power and density with smooth tannins.

Chambolle-Musigny, Domaine Ghislaine Barthod 2009 \$180

High-toned red fruit nose slides into mineral-driven flavors that culminate in a linear finish.

Morey St-Denis 'Clos Solon Vieille Vigne,' Domaine Fourrier 2009 \$180

Silky, black cherry and rhubarb that show brightly against integrated tannins, and finishes clean.

Volnay 1er Cru 'Clos Des Chenes,' Domaine Bernard & Thierry Glantenay 2011 \$209

Plump, pure red fruits and fresh mint with firm yet ripe tannins.

Nuits St. Georges 1er Cru 'Clos Des Forets Saint Georges,' Domaine De L'Arlot 2012 \$283

Feminine, floral, and seductive with sensual earth tones and stewed fruits.

Morey-St-Denis 1er Cru 'Les Chaffots,' Hubert Lignier 2010 \$315

Black and blue fruit held up by balanced acidity and tannin structure.

Gevrey Chambertin 'Aux Echezeaux Vieille Vigne,' Domaine Fourrier 2009 \$350

Red fruits, flowers and tobacco emanate from fine-grained tannins with a hint of bitter chocolate.

## Bordeaux Reds

Fronsac, Château La Grave, Paul Barre 2013 \$80

Biodynamic blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc, with notes of black raspberry & herbs.

Saint Estèphe 'Cru Artisan,' Château La Peyre 2011 \$98

Bright raspberry, savory fine-grained tannins and a strong finish.

Margaux, Château Moulin de Tricot 2011 \$112

A Cabernet-dominant Bordeaux blend, rich yet elegant with great structure & depth.

Pauillac, Château Pedesclaux 2011 \$126

Fresh red currant with cocoa and licorice highlights, revealing smooth and fine tannins.

Saint Julien, Domaine du Jaugaret 2013 \$185

A bouquet of violets followed by rich cassis, graphite & supple tannins.

Saint Estèphe, Château Phélan Ségur 2006 \$210

A cousin wine to Lafite and Latour, with gentle character, structured tannins & barrel nuttiness.

## Rhône Reds

Côtes du Rhone "Les Bateliers," Clos de Caveau 2014 \$55

Silky and elegant with flavors of plums, preserved raspberries and dried herbs.

Gigondas "Cuvée Tradition," Domaine du Gour de Chaulé 2012 \$79

Bold purple hues; a highly perfumed bouquet evokes red and dark berry preserves, and stone fruits.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Tradition, Domaine la Boutinière 2012 \$85

Mature red fruit and cassis with vanilla and balsamic tones leading to a velvety finish.

Cornas "Terre Brulee," Domaine Lionnet 2007 \$90

Delicate yet focused with smoky raspberry flavors and earthy minerals.

Châteauneuf-de-Pape Classic, Domaine de Cristia 2012 \$116

Bold and elegant with complexities of black fruits and herbs with a silky finish.

Cornas "La Geynale," Robert Michel 2006 \$157

Celebrated producer, saturated dark currant fruit with notes of black olive and pepper.

Côte-Rôtie "La Vialliere," Domaine Jean-Michel Gerin 2012 \$255

Black olives and slightly spicy red fruit along with firm tannins display the finesse of Syrah.

## Loire Reds

Cheverny Rouge "Les Hauts de Madon," Christian Venier 2014 \$59

A biodynamic blend of Pinot Noir and Gamay; a wine with ripe fruit, sweet herbs and soft minerality.

Saumur Champigny "Terres Chaudes," Domaine des Roches Neuves 2013 \$60

A Cabernet Franc with a bouquet of cassis and blackberries and a mouthful of ripe tannins.

Chinon "Les Picasses," Olga Raffault 2011 \$60

100% Cabernet Franc; lovely floral aromas, red currants, expressive finish.

Sancerre Rouge "Les Croix du Roy," Lucien Crochet 2011 \$70

100% Pinot Noir; fresh red fruit, food-friendly minerality, supple tannins.

## Italian Reds

Umbria Rosso, Annona 2013 \$47

Dried cherries and herbs are rounded out with soft fruit that is both rustic and delicate.

Chianti Classico, Rodano, Tuscany 2012 \$53

Dried cherry and truffle earthiness lead to a silky texture full of sweet fruit.

Rosso di Montepulciano, Villa Sant'Anna, Tuscany 2012 \$55

Medium-bodied, juicy Sangiovese, fresh black cherry fruit with subtle spicy oak and ripe tannins.

Ciro Rosso Classico Superiore "Dom Guiva," Du Cropio, Calabria 2012 \$64

Made from the alluring Gaglioppo grape, a wine redolent of dark cherry fruit & southern Italian sun.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Poliziano, Tuscany 2012 \$74

A Sangiovese with ample cherry, raspberry, black pepper and earth flavors.

Barbaresco, Marziano Abbona, Piedmont 2010 \$115

Soft and sophisticated with delicate tannins carrying notes of mature red fruit and spices.

Brunello di Montalcino, Ciacci Piccolomini, Tuscany 2009 \$136

From the estate's oldest vineyard with flavors of cherry, strawberry and licorice; firm with a spice-infused finish.

Barolo "Vigneto Brunate," Andrea Oberto 2010 \$172

Dried berry, cedar, chewy tannins and cinnamon notes on the finish.

## New World Reds

Malbec "Petite Fleur," Bodega Monteviejo, Mendoza, Argentina 2012 \$50

Bright and floral nose with an expansive palette of red fruits leading to a long finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, "Margarita Vineyard," Broadside, Paso Robles 2013 \$50

Black currant, plum and tobacco spice are graced with a framework of subtle tannin and acidity.

Merlot, Heron Wines, Mendocino County 2012 \$55

An Old World style Merlot with lots of red cherry and balanced with elegant tannins.

Pinot Noir "Nevermore," Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley 2013 \$60 750ml/ 2014 \$116 1.5L

High tones of raspberry, cranberry, and bing cherry complemented by delicate spices.

Zinfandel, "Three Valleys," Ridge Vineyards, Sonoma 2013 \$62

Well balanced and highly drinkable, with notes of berry jam and grilled mushrooms.

Pinot Noir "Eldritch," Hyland Vineyard, Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley 2013 \$65

Dark fruit, savory hints of thyme and vanilla bean.

Pinot Noir, Erewhon, Waipara and Central Otago, New Zealand 2013 \$65

Aromas of vanilla, candied fruit and thyme with a luscious mouthfeel and chalky, fine tannins.

Pinot Noir, "Maelstrom," Gothic, Willamette Valley 2012 \$75

Whole cluster fermentation yields firm, elegant texture with red fruits, anise and sweet birch.

Grenache "Les Garçons," Fausse Piste, Columbia Valley 2011 \$84

Single vineyard Grenache from acclaimed Pacific Northwest producer; dark berry fruit with elegant minerals.

Cabernet, "Old Hill Ranch," Bucklin, Sonoma 2013 \$85

Organic traditional wine from the oldest vineyard in Sonoma; big currant nose, with blackberries on the palate.

Pinot Noir "Sonoma Coast Cuvée," Baker Lane Vineyards, Sonoma Coast 2014 \$92

Full of red and black fruits, with a structured and luxurious finish.

Cabernet blend "POV" Robert Sinskey, Los Carneros 2012 \$95

Right Bank Bordeaux blend; dark purple, iron, fresh dark berries.

Pinot Noir "Maresh Vineyards," Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley 2011 \$95

Wild roses on the nose, silky in texture with a feminine expression.

Syrah, "Stagecoach Vineyard," Skylark, Napa 2009 \$112

Blueberry, plum and sweet tobacco and chocolate undertones fold into a long supple finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Castrucci Estate, Napa 2013 \$120

Ripe blackberry and cherry evolve into mint and flowers carried on mouth watering fine grained tannins.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Heitz Cellar, Napa 2012 \$155

A silky rich palate of fresh-picked black fruits, at once both charming and complex.

Cabernet Sauvignon, "La Jota Vineyard Co.," Howell Mountain 2013 \$195

Anise and blackberry aromas that explode with blueberry and mocha on a lush palate with rocky minerality.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Chappellet, Pritchard Hill 2010 \$315

Aromas of blackberry, dark chocolate and cedar perfume this brooding, top notch Cabernet blend.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Continuum, Napa 2012 \$362

Black cherry and bitter chocolate with rich, lingering finish.

## Spanish Reds

Roble, Ruben Ramos, Ribera del Duero 2013 \$50

Spicy red currant and cherry aromas are complemented by cracked pepper and violet. Fresh yet structured.

Priorat "Black Slate," Gratallops, Celler Cecilio 2014 \$59

Ripe dark berries and allspice meet soft tannins while licorice lingers on the finish.

Lalama, Dominio do Bibei, Ribeira Sacra 2010 \$90

100-year-old vines of Mencia and Grenache; plum, dried violets and stony tannins.

PSI "Domino de Pingus," Ribera Del Duero 2013 \$93

100% Tempranillo; a mouthful of tannins followed by released layers of rich soil and dark fruit.

Rioja Reserva, Vina Tondonia, Lopez de Heredia 2003 \$99

From the family owned winery that set the standard for elegance in Rioja. Aged 6 years in barrel, 4 in bottle.

Rioja Gran Reserva "904," Alta 2005 \$110

Cask-aged with bright aromas of dried berries, cherry, vanilla and potpourri with complex spices.

Priorat, Clos Martinet 2010 \$152

A blend of Grenache and Carignan, this is a rich, dark, brooding wine of profound depth and complexity.

## Other Old World Reds

Malbec, Domaine Brunet, Cahors, France 2014 \$41

Lush red fruits with a note of licorice; round and balanced palate.

Kadarka, Bukolyi, Szekszárd, Hungary 2013 \$53

100% Kadarka, full-bodied and rich with red fruits and spice with light tannins.

Douro Tinto, Antonio Lopes Ribeiro, Douro, Portugal 2012 \$55

Beautiful Biodynamic dry red with black cherry and muscular minerality.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Mas de Daumas Gassac, IGP Pays de l'Herault, France 2012 \$93

Elegant Cabernet blend, bold structure, fresh peppery fruit.

## Half Bottles

Chardonnay, Talley Vineyards, Arroyo Grande Valley 2013 \$40

An elegant expression of Chardonnay with supple baked apple notes and a long, mineral finish.

Syrah, Baker Lane Vineyards, Sonoma Coast 2012 \$50

Lush berry fruit, chewy tannins and a velvety texture enrobe the palate.

Gevrey Chambertin, Domaine Harmand Geoffroy, Cotes De Nuits 2011 \$75

Rich yet graceful Pinot Noir with wild berry notes; classic Burgundy.

Billecart-Salmon, Brut Rosé, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ NV \$95

Elegant hints of strawberry, tangerine, and flowers, with lively pink bubbles.
