Aromas of citrus and apple lead to an elegant, mouthwatering palate.

Crémant De Bourgogne Rosé, Parigot, France NV \$63
100% pinot noir - fresh pink berries with a refreshing finish.

Ployez-Jacquemart, Extra Quality Brut, Reims NV \$95
A bouquet of apple, grilled bread and almond notes both full-bodied and zesty.

Pierre Moncuit, Brut Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru, Les Mesnil-sur-Oger NV \$120
Baked apple, pastry and spice are infused in a layered, voluptuous finish.

Billecart-Salmon, Brut Reserve, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ NV \$142 750ml / \$294 1.5L
Pinot Meunier-dominant with flavors of toasted brioche, lemon curd, & evaporating soft bubbles.

Vilmart & Cie Brut, 'Grand Cellier,' Reims NV \$163
A luxury Champagne fermented in antique barrels with aromas of orange blossom, mint, herbs & spice.

Billecart-Salmon Brut Rosé, Mareuil-sur-Aÿ NV \$95 375ml / \$220 750ml / \$418 1.5L
Elegant hints of strawberry, tangerine, and flowers, with lively pink bubbles.

Burgundy Whites

Mâcon, Bourcier-Martinot 2015 \$45
Fresh, unoaked flavors of pear and lemon with a clean mineral zip.

Vire-Clesse, 'Thévenet', Domaine de Roally 2014 \$65
Elegant and exotic, with fresh tropical fruit and stoney acidity.

Chablis 1er Cru, 'Vaucoupin,' Domaine Servin 2014 \$76
Clean and fresh palate with notes of pink grapefruit and lemon, with golden pineapple and brown sugar on the nose.

Pouilly-Fuissé, 'Tête De Cru,' Château-Fuissé 2014 \$77
Ripeness with meyer lemon and honey, creamy mouthfeel with floral and spice notes.

Meursault, Domaine Prieur-Brunet 2013 \$126
Complex on the palate showing rhubarb, truffles and toasted hazelnut notes.

Meursault, 'Clos du Cromin', Domaine Genot Boulanger 2012 \$130
Aromas of light citrus with crisp acidity and a lingering toasted oak finish.

Pernand-Vergelesses 1er Cru, 'Sous Frétille', Domaine Antonin Guyon 2012 \$153
Fragrant white flowers evolve into honey and spice with harmonious minerality.

Meursault-Genévrières 1er Cru, Domaine Francois et Antoine Jobard 2005 \$160
Notes of almonds and grilled hazelnuts lay alongside delicate orange blossom and silky minerality.

Puligny-Montrachet, Domaine Hubert Bouzereau-Gruère & Filles 2012 \$205
Expressions of acacia, hazelnut, vanilla and white pepper with great finesse and freshness.

Loire Whites

Sancerre, Domaine de la Chézatte 2016 \$46

Floral pear and grapefruit with a limestone spark that's both bright and light.

Pouilly-Fumé, Pascal Jolivet 2016 \$58

Focused citrus and mineral aromas with layered clean, driving acidity.

Sancerre, 'Apud Sarracum', Philippe Raimbault 2015 \$59

Fresh grapefruit and green plum mingle with bracing minerality and refined spice on the finish.

Vouvray Sec, 'Domaine du Clos Naudin', Philippe Foreau 2013 \$74

Dried pineapple, brown sugar, crisp minerality with vibrant acidity; mouth-watering.

Sancerre, 'La Croix du Roy,' Lucien Crochet 2015 \$81

Crisp minerality with fresh lime and grapefruit flavors from a renowned Sancerre producer.

Rhône Whites

Roussanne, Jeanne Gaillard 2015 \$52

Very aromatic and perfectly balanced with a very mineral finish. Floral and honeyed notes.

Viognier, 'Les Contours de Deponcins', François Villard 2014 \$77

A floral nose that leads to a palate of sweet nectarines and plum.

Côtes du Rhône Blanc, 'Les Gendrines', Pierre Gaillard 2014 \$88

Spiced toffee and peach compote mingle with black tea and white flowers, rich and balanced.

Châteauneuf du Pape Blanc, Domaine Bois de Boursan 2013 \$95

A blend of Rhone white grapes with exotic aromatics and an unctuous, stony mouthfeel.

Other Old World Whites

Gavi DOCG, Tenuta San Pietro, Piedmont, Italy 2016 \$47

A bright, piedmont white with a floral, stony nose, fresh acidity and a lingering finish.

Kerner, Abbazia di Novacella, Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy 2016 \$55

A dry, perfumey wine from the Kerner grape; reminiscent of both Riesling and Gewurztraminer with notes of peach & mango.

Cassis Blanc, Domaine du Bagnol, Provence, France 2014 \$55

A blend of Marsanne, Clairette and Ugni Blanc, this dry, juicy wine tastes of lychee, white pear, and minerals.

Riesling, 'Cuvée Albert', Albert Mann, Alsace, France 2015 \$60

Bouquet of white flowers with juicy peaches and melon; snappy and dry.

Chardonnay, Pomino Benefizio Riserva DOC, Frescobaldi, Tuscany 2014 \$120

A unique Chardonnay with aromas of flowers and tropical fruit, blending with spicy scents and delicate wood notes.

New World Whites

Chardonnay, Fox Run, Finger Lakes, New York 2016 \$47

Unoaked upstate New York Chardonnay with notes of apple & nectarine, balanced with citrusy acidity.

Chardonnay, 'Ophelia', Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley, Oregon 2014 \$62

Crisp and vibrant with neutral oak and notes of yellow apple, summer melon and lemon confit.

Viognier, 'The Alpine Selection', Fausse Piste, Columbia Valley 2013 \$60

Grown at high altitude in the Columbia River Gorge this wine is rich, full-bodied with generous stone fruit notes.

Chardonnay, Hanna, Russian River Valley, California 2014 \$64

Creamy lemon curd and roasted nuts with a wisp of tropical fruit and a fresh, lively mouthfeel.

Pinot Gris, Bethel Heights, Eola-Amity Hills, Oregon 2015 \$69

Soft honeydew, elderflower, and clove with a sturdy mineral backbone.

Sauvignon Blanc, 'Equitem,' Galerie, Knights Valley, California 2014 \$75

Aromas of juicy melon with flavors of orange blossom and passion fruit paired with a complex mouthfeel.

Chardonnay, 'Lindaflor', Bodega Montevejo, Valle de Uco, Argentina 2013 \$79

Tropical fruits, apple and buttered toast are balanced with great acidity and a long finish.

Sauvignon Blanc, Merry Edwards, Russian River Valley, California 2015 \$108

Smooth and succulent melon, pear and white peach sing with the richness of french barrel age.

Chardonnay, Kistler 'Les Noisetiers', Sonoma Coast, California 2014 \$155

Full and unctuous with notes of orchard fruit, cream, and vanilla.

Chardonnay, 'The Judge', Kongsgaard, Napa, California 2008 \$395

A truly outstanding vintage from a highly-acclaimed producer. Alluring spices with a dense yet lively finish.

Rosé Wine

Gothic 'Telltale', Willamette Valley 2016 \$48

Provence style, bright acidity, notes of lemon meringue and cherry blossom.

Bandol Rosé, Domiane la Suffrene, Provence, France 2016 \$61

Fleshy, full-bodied with orange and banana aromas, fresh strawberries and a slightly peppery finish.

Burgundy Reds

Gamay Noir, Bonnet Rouge, Beaujolais 2013 \$41

A blend of all Cru Beaujolais wines with strawberry notes and lovely aromatics.

St. Amour, 'Les Champs Grilles', Domaine Cheveau 2013 \$51

Juicy Beaujolais that bursts with red berries and freshness.

Mercurey, Château de Chamirey 2015 \$72

Raspberry, licorice, and tobacco with a dark cocoa and spice backbone.

Hautes Côtes de Nuits, 'Les Dames de Vergy', Domaine Antonin Guyon 2012 \$81

Aromas of blackberries and spice with a creamy texture and long finish.

Chorey-les-Beaune, 'Les Bons Ores', Domaine Edmond Cornu et Fils 2013 \$86

Bright berries and earth linger on a silky texture and great tannic structure.

Auxey-Duresses, Domaine Billard 2013 \$90

An elegant Pinot Noir with notes of red berries and spice with a lingering finish.

Ladoix 1er Cru, 'Bois Roussot', Domaine Edmond Cornu et Fils 2013 \$114

Fresh blackberry and currant on the nose belie the elegance and complexity of this star wine.

Bourgogne Rouge, 'Grand Chaliot', Domaine Hubert Lignier 2014 \$125

World class pinot with perfumed, briary nose and gamy tart black fruit.

Volnay 1er Cru, 'Clos Des Chenes', Domaine Bernard & Thierry Glantenay 2011 \$209

Plump, pure red fruits and fresh mint with firm yet ripe tannins.

Nuits St. Georges 1er Cru, 'Clos Des Forets Saint Georges', Domaine De L'Arlot 2012 \$283

Feminine, floral, and seductive with sensual earth tones and stewed fruits.

Morey-St-Denis 1er Cru, 'Les Chaffots', Domaine Hubert Lignier 2010 \$315

Black and blue fruit held up by balanced acidity and tannin structure.

Gevrey Chambertin, 'Aux Echezeaux Vieille Vigne', Domaine Fourrier 2009 \$350

Red fruits, flowers and tobacco emanate from fine-grained tannins with a hint of bitter chocolate.

Bordeaux Reds

Haut-Médoc, Château Larrivaux, Bordeaux 2012 \$54

A structured Bordeaux blend with oaked notes of blackcurrant and cherry.

Fronsac, Château La Grave, Paul Barre 2013 \$80

Biodynamic blend of Merlot and Cabernet Franc, with notes of black raspberry & herbs.

Margaux, Château Moulin de Tricot 2013 \$115

A Cabernet-dominant Bordeaux blend, rich yet elegant with great structure & depth.

Saint Estèphe Grand Cru Classé, Château Cos Labory 2010 \$152

A rich beautiful bouquet of strawberry, black cherry, black currant and toast.

Saint Julien, Domaine du Jaugaret 2012 \$185

A bouquet of violets followed by rich cassis, graphite & supple tannins.

Saint Julien, 3ème Grand Cru Classé, Château Lagrange 2007 \$236

Crisp red fruits with hints of tobacco, pepper, and cedar.

Haut Medoc, 5ème Grand Cru Classé, Château Chantemerle 2003 \$290 1.5L

Dark fruit, leather, tobacco balanced with earthy minerality and melty tannins.

Saint Estèphe, 3ème Grand Cru Classé, Château Calon-Ségur 2005 \$345

Intense-but-elegant layers of black fruit melt into an earthy finish.

Rhône Reds

Côtes du Rhône, 'Sud Absolu', Domaine La Ligière 2015 \$39

Satin smooth texture which has a complex range of berry flavors.

Côtes du Rhône, 'Les Bateliers', Clos de Caveau 2015 \$55

Silky and elegant with flavors of plums, preserved raspberries and dried herbs.

Gigondas, 'Cuvée Tradition', Domaine du Gour de Chaulé 2013 \$79

Bold purple hues; a highly perfumed bouquet evokes red and dark berry preserves, and stone fruits.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Tradition, Domaine la Boutinière 2013 \$82

Mature red fruit and cassis with vanilla and balsamic tones leading to a velvety finish.

Saint-Joseph Rouge, Pierre Gaillard 2012 \$88

Silky, fine-grained texture with red berries, cracked pepper and olive perfume.

Côte-Rôtie, 'La Vialliere', Domaine Jean-Michel Gerin 2012 \$255

Black olives and slightly spicy red fruit along with firm tannins display the finesse of Syrah.

Loire Reds

Cheverny, 'Les Hauts de Madon', Christian Venier 2014 \$54

A biodynamic blend of Pinot Noir and Gamay; a wine with ripe fruit, sweet herbs and soft minerality.

Saumur Champigny, 'Terres Chaudes', Domaine des Roches Neuves 2013 \$60

A Cabernet Franc with a bouquet of cassis and blackberries and a mouthful of ripe tannins.

Chinon, 'Les Picasses', Olga Raffault 2013 \$80

100% Cabernet Franc; lovely floral aromas, red currants, expressive finish.

Spanish Reds

Rioja Cosecha, Hermanos de Pecina Seniorio 2015 \$45

Fruit driven and spicy with an intensely perfumed nose and bright finish.

Roble, Ruben Ramos, Ribera del Duero 2014 \$50

Spicy red currant and cherry aromas are complemented by cracked pepper and violet. Fresh yet structured.

Priorat, 'Black Slate', Gratallops, Celler Cecilio 2014 \$59

Ripe dark berries and allspice meet soft tannins while licorice lingers on the finish.

Lalama, Dominio do Bibeí, Ribeira Sacra 2010 \$90

100-year-old vines of Mencia and Grenache; plum, dried violets and stony tannins.

PSI, 'Dominio de Pingus', Ribera Del Duero 2014 \$93

100% Tempranillo; a mouthful of tannins followed by released layers of rich soil and dark fruit.

Rioja Reserva, Vina Tondonia, Lopez de Heredia 2004 \$99

From the family owned winery that set the standard for elegance in Rioja. Aged 6 years in barrel, 4 in bottle.

Priorat, Clos Martinet 2010 \$152

A blend of Grenache and Carignan, this is a rich, dark, brooding wine of profound depth and complexity.

Rioja Gran Reserva, '904,' Alta 2007 \$260 1.5L

Cask-aged with bright aromas of dried berries, cherry, vanilla and potpourri with complex spices.

Italian Reds

Barbera d'Alba, 'Madama', Gianni Gagliardo, Piedmont 2014 \$42

Soft and elegant with a raspberry and sweet hay nose, and depth on the palate.

Nebbiolo, Coste della Sesia DOC, Travaglini, Piedmont 2015 \$46

Dark fruits with violet and licorice notes lead to a silky, lasting finish

Rosso di Montepulciano, Villa Sant'Anna, Tuscany 2013 \$55

Medium-bodied, juicy Sangiovese, fresh black cherry fruit with subtle spicy oak and ripe tannins.

Chianti Classico, Lornano, Tuscany 2011 \$59

Blackberry and wild wood, this nuanced Chianti is 100% Sangiovese.

Rosso di Montalcino, Barbi, Tuscany 2015 \$74

Red berries and currants with soft tannins and bright acidity leading to a long finish.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Poliziano, Tuscany 2013 \$79

A Sangiovese with ample cherry, raspberry, black pepper and earth flavors.

Barbaresco, Marziano Abbona, Piedmont 2010 \$115

Soft and sophisticated with delicate tannins carrying notes of mature red fruit and spices.

Chianti Classico Gran Selezione, Lornano, Tuscany 2011 \$135

Combining blackberry, wild cherry and sweet spices with a warm, persistent finish.

Brunello di Montalcino, Ciacci Piccolomini, Tuscany 2012 \$142

From the estate's oldest vineyard with flavors of cherry, strawberry and licorice; firm with a spice-infused finish.

Barolo, 'Vigneto Brunate', Andrea Oberto 2010 \$172

Dried berry, cedar, chewy tannins and cinnamon notes on the finish.

Other Old World Reds

Malbec, Domaine Brunet, Cahors, France 2016 \$41

Lush red fruits with a note of licorice; round and balanced palate.

Kadarka, Bukolyi, Szekszárd, Hungary 2013 \$53

100% Kadarka, full-bodied and rich with red fruits and spice with light tannins.

Douro Tinto, António Lopes Ribeiro, Douro, Portugal 2012 \$55

Beautiful Biodynamic dry red with black cherry and muscular minerality.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Mas de Daumas Gassac, IGP Pays de l'Hérault, France 2012 \$93

"The Grand Cru of the Languidoc". Complex fruit character, earthy depth and a rich, earthy backbone.

New World Reds

Syrah, Baker Lane Vineyards, Sonoma Coast 2012 \$50 375ml Half Bottle
Lush berry fruit, chewy tannins and a velvety texture enrobe the palate.

Malbec, 'Petite Fleur', Bodega Montevejo, Mendoza, Argentina 2012 \$50
Bright and floral nose with an expansive palette of red fruits leading to a long finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, 'Margarita Vineyard', Broadside, Paso Robles 2014 \$50
Black currant, plum and tobacco spice are graced with a framework of subtle tannin and acidity.

Pinot Noir, 'Nevermore', Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley 2014 \$60 750ml / \$116 1.5L
High tones of raspberry, cranberry, and bing cherry complemented by delicate spices.

Zinfandel, 'Three Valleys', Ridge Vineyards, Sonoma 2014 \$62
Well balanced and highly drinkable, with notes of berry jam and grilled mushrooms.

Pinot Noir, 'Eldritch', Hyland Vineyard, Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley 2013 \$65
Dark fruit, savory hints of thyme and vanilla bean.

Pinot Noir, Erewhon, Waipara and Central Otago, New Zealand 2013 \$65
Aromas of vanilla, candied fruit and thyme with a luscious mouthfeel and chalky, fine tannins.

Pinot Noir, 'Maelstrom', Gothic, Willamette Valley 2012 \$75
Whole cluster fermentation yields firm, elegant texture with red fruits, anise and sweet birch.

Cabernet blend, 'POV', Robert Sinskey, Los Carneros 2012 \$95
Right Bank Bordeaux blend; dark purple, iron, fresh dark berries.

Pinot Noir, 'Maresh Vineyards', Gothic Wine, Willamette Valley 2011 \$95
Wild roses on the nose, silky in texture with a feminine expression.

Cabernet, 'Old Hill Ranch', Bucklin, Sonoma 2014 \$105
Organic traditional wine from the oldest vineyard in Sonoma; big currant nose, with blackberries on the palate.

Zinfandel, Cederman, Turley Wine Cellars, Howell Mountain 2015 \$112
Berries and spice dominate in this powerful, dense, and wild wine; long on flavor.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Heitz Cellar, Napa 2012 \$155
A silky rich palate of fresh-picked black fruits, at once both charming and complex.

Cabernet Sauvignon, 'La Jota Vineyard Co.', Howell Mountain 2012 \$195
Anise and blackberry aromas that explode with blueberry and mocha on a lush palate with rocky minerality.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Corison Wines, Napa 2014 \$210
Dark plum and black raspberry stand out against a backbone of smoke, cedar, and rosemary.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Robert Sinskey, Stags Leap District 2011 \$296
Blackberry, cassis, and violet offset elegantly with dried thyme, pepper and leathery tea.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Chappellet, Pritchard Hill 2010 \$315
Aromas of blackberry, dark chocolate and cedar perfume this brooding, top notch Cabernet blend.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Continuum, Napa 2012 \$362
Black cherry and bitter chocolate with rich, lingering finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon Blend, Rudd Oakville Estate Red, Napa 2012 \$420
Concentrated blackberry and cherry with delicate violet and rich cooking spice.
