

Reminder about Tuition and Fees

Upon acceptance of the contract, parent(s) or guardian(s) are responsible for the full tuition indicated on the contract, per the terms of the contract.

FACTS Tuition Management

All families are required to register with our online billing system known as FACTS. The system allows families to make automatic online payments for tuition and incidental fees.

Tuition Payment Options

Parents have the option of (1) making one annual tuition payment, (2) electing the semester payment schedule, or (3) contracting with our tuition management company, FACTS, for a 10-month tuition payment plan.

What does tuition cover?

Tuition covers the major portion of instructional and academic costs as well as the cost of instructional materials (e.g., science, music and physical education supplies) and routine diagnostic testing.

Inclusive Student Fee

This annual fee is paid in 9 monthly installments, unless families elect to pay in full.

Included in fee: textbooks, iPad device, educational content and iPad insurance, classroom consumables, Primary School snack, Gr. 5-12 athletic uniforms/fees, math/science/ROV/foreign language competitions, and class trips, camps (Manito-wish, Washington D.C., Cincinnati/Indianapolis/Springfield/Hannibal, Timberlee) Gr. 7-12 yearbook, performing arts scripts, scores and dress/tuxedo, PSAT exam, graduation.

Not included: Lunch fees, Kenosha/Franklin/Oak Creek buses, Stay and Play, Interim trips, Model UN, shoes for athletics/performing arts, custom clothing, lost school - provided materials, specially arranged individual diagnostic or psychological testing, externally administered testing programs (SAT/ACT), AP exams, ELL fees, speech therapy.

Stay & Play

7:15 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Prairie offers a flexible before and after-school program known as Stay & Play. This program is also available on most early-release days and for the first week during Spring Break. The charge is \$5.50/hour per child; families are billed on a monthly basis.

Food Service/Lunch Program

Each day, a high quality, well-balanced meal is prepared and available at a reasonable cost. The lunch program is optional for students.
