

Early School Supply List

- Family photograph that can stay in your child's locker all year
- Extra set of clothing in a small plastic bag to keep at school. Please label everything with your child's name.
- Pair of velcro gym shoes either worn to school or kept in your child's locker for gym time
- Standard size backpack
- Elmer's all purpose glue sticks in Disappearing Purple. JUMBO size - 0.77 oz. (5)
- Elmer's all purpose glue sticks in Disappearing Purple. Regular size - 0.24 oz. (5)
- Boxes of Crayola Pip-Squeaks 16 ct. (2)
- Boxes Crayola Pip-Squeaks Skinnies Washable Markers 16 ct. (2)
- Washable Watercolors 8 ct. (1)
- Boxes of 24 standard size Crayola Crayons (2)
- Box of Kleenex (1)
- Bottle of low/no alcohol hand sanitizer 8 oz. or larger - i.e. Babyganics from Target (1)
- Packages of Cottonelle Fresh Wipes to help with the children's personal hygiene in our bathrooms. We will keep a container in each bathroom to share. (2)
- Sleeping bag that will go on top of a cot for rest time. A small pillow and/or stuffed animal are optional. **(FULL DAY STUDENTS ONLY)**

There is no need to label the supplies other than the folders, as they will be part of the "community" supply. We may ask for replacement crayons and/or markers at some point during the school year.
