A Day in the Life

9:00 Join your supervisor in a meeting with a coalition to discuss an upcoming white paper on a health policy issue.

12:30 Connect with design team to review

10:00 Conduct an opportunity scan to identify timely issues that our clients can leverage through a blog post, earned media, or another platform.

10:30 Brainstorm session to find angles for pitching a client's story to media.

12:00 Interview a team member from another office and learn more about the work of one of your colleagues in another HLG location.
