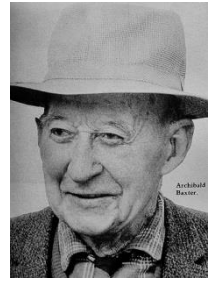


# Archibald Baxter Memorial Trust

## 2017 Memorial Video Competition

### For Area and Secondary Schools and Tertiary Institutions

**Theme:** a video capable of being uploaded to YouTube of maximum 5 minutes duration on the topic **Building Peace in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.**

The theme should take its inspiration from the pacifist stance of Archibald Baxter – a prominent peace activist and conscientious objector during the First World War.

### Rules

There are two categories: New Zealand Area and secondary schools (students from Year 7 upwards) and New Zealand tertiary educational institutions.

Both categories will be awarded equal prizes - \$500 plus three books for the winner and two further prizes of three books for the runners up (six prizes in all).

The video may be the work of a single submitter or a team. There is no limit to the number of people who may be involved with any one submission.

Any number of entries may come from the one school or tertiary institution.

The Trust will have the right to exhibit any or all of the entries on its website...
