THE REGION

The Central Victorian region of Heathcote is famed for its ancient Cambrian red soils which are over 100 million years old. These soils & the region's warm & dry climate produce wines with inky colour & wonderful fruit flavour.

WINE MAKING

This 2014 Red Hill Estate Heathcote Shiraz shows characters typical of the variety from this region.

The grapes were harvested from selected premium vineyards in Heathcote for optimum quality and show deep purples and red in colour that mix beautifully with aroma's of plum, spice and blackcherries.

On the palate there are flavours of spice and white pepper that lead to an intensely flavoured, well rounded yet relatively soft mouth feel of dark blackberries, blood plum and redcherries finishing with cedar and dusty oak.

Medium bodied in weight with a balanced acidity and lingering length, this 2014 selection is a very impressive Heathcote Shiraz that is perfectly reflective of both the Heathcote region and the renowned quality of Red Hill Estate.
