Thank you for your interest in Indiana's wildlife.

Since the removal of the bobcat season proposed rule at the May NRC meeting, DNR has not hosted any meetings to advance another proposed bobcat season. On October 2nd, at the request of several area legislators, DNR representatives attended a meeting in Dubois County to present information on the rulemaking process and previously proposed bobcat season and answer questions.

At this time, DNR does not have any meetings planned or scheduled to discuss starting a new proposed bobcat season. Any meeting hosted by DNR is a public meeting that is open to everyone, and must follow open door law requirements, which include public notice prior to the meeting being held.
