

Weather Policy



Weather Policy across the club: If we have to cancel due to weather, DUSC will send an email or text out to inform you that your session has been cancelled. If you do not receive an email from DUSC then the session is *on*. Please *do not* email or call simply due to the volume of correspondence we receive. Coaches may decide to cancel once he or she gets to the field if they feel that it is not safe to play.

Recreation League

- For all leagues starting before 12:00pm we will make a decision at 7:00am and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.
- For those after 12:00pm we will make a decision at 10:30am and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.

Classes

- For weekday classes we will make a decision by 1pm and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.
- For weekend classes starting before 12:00pm we will make a decision at 7:00am and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.
- For weekend classes starting after 12:00pm we will make a decision at 10:30am and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.

Academy/travel

Practices

- For weekday practices we will make a decision by 2:00pm and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.
- For weekend practices starting before 12:00pm we will make a decision at 7:00am and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.
- For those after 12:00pm we will make a decision at 10:30am and will send out an email if we decide to cancel.

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EDP Weather Policy

Weather Cancellation

- The referee or the club/facility may cancel the days matches prior to 9:00am.
 - Keeping travel of the opposing team in mind when determining a cancellation.
- Teams must notify the league that day if a game is canceled due to weather.
 - Teams will notify John Pompeo, john@mssl.org, of any unplayed game.
 - Games that are canceled must be rescheduled by the following Friday at 5:00pm.
 - If the game goes unscheduled the home team will be assessed a forfeit.

CJSL Weather Policy

The Games Chairman may cancel games in the case of inclement weather conditions.

Inclement weather may include:

- Heavy rain
- Snow
- Extreme winds
- Sleet, icing
- Extreme cold temperatures (in the case of U8–U12)
- Other conditions deemed unsafe by the Games Chairman.

Clubs and referee shall obtain information by telephone or email, at least 2 hours before game time, from the Games Chairman in order to ascertain whether the scheduled game can be played before starting the trip to the opponent's field. If no contact takes place between the games chairman and club, then games will be presumed to be on as scheduled.

WYSL Weather Policy

Notice to league president. In addition, if there is general inclement weather, the home club MUST call the WYSL president (or his/her designee) on Sunday morning between 8:00 – 9:00am to notify him or her of any field pulls up to that time. The president will inform the referee assignor (wsroassignor@gmail.com) to cancel the referee coverage for that field. The president will also tabulate the number of pulls; and, if it exceeds 50% of scheduled games of the day, the entire slate of games will be canceled and not rescheduled and a notice will be posted on the league website. In addition to informing the president, the club president may also email the ref assignor. No games will be cancelled by the League after 10:00 a.m.

Appearance at field. In bad weather, teams should not assume that a game will be cancelled. The team must appear at the field of play regardless of weather conditions, unless the team's coach has been notified that the field is pulled and the game cancelled.
