



Poster Guidelines

General Information

The area for displaying poster materials is 4' high X 8' wide less a 2" frame on all four sides. The surface is fiberboard contained in a 2" wide frame and firmly supported on "A frame" legs. The display stands approximately 7' high.

Please keep text and figure legends explicit and brief. Illustrations must be read from distances of approximately 4'.

Pushpins will be provided to mount your poster materials. Do not mount your presentation materials on heavy poster board because they may be difficult to keep in position.

Do not write or draw on the (poster board surface

Presentation Period

Posters should be mounted for display no later than **10:00 AM on Thursday, May 10th in Room 258 B-C.**

Viewing and judging of posters will take place between **12:30 and 2:00 PM.** Be at your posters by 12:30. Lunch will be available at 12:00.

We ask that you remain with your poster during this period of time in order to answer questions and expand on the material for interested visitors.

Poster may be left up to be viewed during the main meeting.

If a poster is not removed by the end of the meeting, we will assume that the presenter wants the poster material discarded.

Finalists

Basic Science and Clinical Finalists should mount their posters at boards so designated. Please remain with your posters until the judges arrive.

You will have a total of **8-10 minutes** to present you poster to the judges. This will be followed by a brief Q&A period.

Two first prize awards (\$1,000 each for basic research and clinical research) and two runner- ups (\$500 each) will be announced at the end of the CES session
