### Crime update June 2017

There has been an attempted theft from a motor vehicle reported in the area of All Saints Road where the lock has reportedly been drilled. No items were taken.

There has also been a theft from motor vehicle where tools were taken in the area of Hall Farm Road. No sign of forced entry and believed vehicle was left unlocked by mistake.

### Crime prevention advice

There have been reports in Leicestershire of distraction breaks this month. The suspect approaches the house holder claiming to be from the water board and states that dye has been placed in the water. The homeowner is asked to run a tap and look for the colour change. During this the suspect steals items belonging to the occupant.

### Good news

There was an incident in Rothley were two males were seen in a building site. The males were spotted near to machinery on the site.
