### FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Read John 3:25. What was the argument or disagreement concerning?
2. Peter's preference for food choices differed from Cornelius. What did God tell Peter about his preference? Read Acts 10:1-15?
3. Pastor Daniel said, "Following Jesus will cost you your preferences." How can having a "He greater than i" lifestyle prevent us from quarreling over differences and focus on loving each other? (Matt.22:39)
4. Read John 3:26. What point did John's disciples bring him as a warning message?
5. If you have a "He greater than i" lifestyle do you need acknowledgement of the things you do for the kingdom of God? Explain.
6. Pastor Daniel said, "Following Jesus will cost you your praise and recognition." Do you ever serve or love others for the sake of Christ and His honor in ways no one else knows?
7. What was John's reply to his disciples' case for preferences and recognition? Read John 3:30.
8. Pastor Daniel said, "Following Jesus will cost you everything." What is gained when you give up all that you are to follow Jesus? Read John 14

### FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away

**He greater than i:**

- **Following Jesus will cost you your preferences... what in your daily life is a preference you give up because you want to have a life that puts Jesus preferences before your own.**
- **Following Jesus will cost you your praise and recognition...what in your daily life is something do to show love to others because of your love for God without getting praise or recognition.**
- **Following Jesus will cost you everything...what in your daily life is an area where you must decrease and allow God to increase.**
- **When love leads – He becomes greater than i**
