FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. What is your understanding of the work and personhood of the Holy Spirit?
2. Pastor Steve said, “The Holy Spirit is an active and legitimate everyday relationship that you ought to be cultivating in your life.” Do you interact with the Holy Spirit? If so, how and how often?
3. Read Acts 1:4-5. Jesus said, “You will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” Is it the same as John the Baptist baptism in water? Explain.
4. Pastor Steve said, “John’s baptism was a physically symbolic more religious oriented experience...the baptism of Jesus in the Holy Spirit...was personal, spiritually supernatural not religious, not ritual.” John’s baptism involved the follower of Jesus to be immersed in water. What is the follower of Jesus immersed in with Jesus baptism?
5. Water baptism is a key step in the life of a believer, not so much the type of baptism but the outward ceremonial decision to follow Jesus. How is Baptism in the Holy Spirit different?
6. Pastor Steve said, “The baptism in the Holy Spirit that Jesus is talking about is far more complete. It is a submersing in the Holy Spirit but in a way, that completely infiltrates, fills in, saturates the person.” Read Acts 2:1-4. What does it say happened to the people in the room?
