FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Pastor Steve said, “The Holy Spirit is just as important as the Father and the Son. You can know the Holy Spirit like you know the Father and the Son.” Do you have a personal relationship and interact with God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit? Explain.
2. Read Acts 19:3-4. What purpose did John the Baptist baptize people?
3. Pastor Steve said, “John’s baptism was really a physical demonstration...that you would follow Jesus.” Read Acts 19:5-6. What happened next?
4. What happened when Paul laid his hands on the people in verse 6?
5. Pastor Steve said, “The best interpretation of this phrase “come on” is in keeping with the theme of baptism. It came upon them from within...” Where was the Holy Spirit when they were baptized and Paul laid hands on them?
6. Read Romans 8:5-13 and Galatians 5:16-25. In what way is it important for a Christian to have the Holy Spirit of his or her life just as he or she has a personal relationship with the Father and the Son?

FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away

The Holy Spirit:

- **A Pentecostal is a Christian who believes that the empowerment of the church, by the Holy Spirit, to be witnesses of the Good News of Jesus.**
- **Invite the Holy Spirit to be an active part of your life.**
