FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. When we can't see our way through difficulties it becomes harder in our human state to trust in God. What does Proverbs 3:5-6 instruct us to do?
2. Read 1st Samuel 1:19-28. Who did Hannah place her trust in?
3. How can we trust in God without the details of understanding how it will all work out?
4. Pastor Phillicia Wilson said, "My heart reminds my mind that I trust God...I pull from the resources of my heart to remind me I trust God and let my brain know I trust God." How can we get our hearts to have the resources to remind our minds that we trust God? Read Psalm 119:11.
5. Read Genesis 21:17-18. Who did Hagar place her trust in?
6. Pastor Phillicia Wilson said, "We need to trust God...with His will and His will is not always our expected results...But first we need to trust God to love us." If we trust God to love us in His perfect love, how can that help us accept His Will even if it's not what we expect? Can you give an example?
7. Read Luke 1:34-38. Who did Mary place her trust in?
8. Pastor Phillicia Wilson said, "When we trust God we have to trust Him through the process." Often, we wait for trust to be proven. How did God prove that we can trust Him? Read John 3:16.

FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away

- Trusting God does not depend on how others trust God, we need a personal relationship with God to trust in Him for ourselves
