FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Can you share something you told someone that was a lie or something you considered to say that was not true?
2. Pastor Steve said, “There are two main motivations for this whole sense of lying; fear or desire.” In your shared answer to question one; was the lie or thought to lie response to avoid a consequence or to achieve something you want?
3. Can you provide an example of an answer you received or provided that included an added oath to add value to the statement?
4. Read Matthew 5:33-37. Why does this verse tell us that our word is enough for someone to trust what we are saying is truth?
5. Pastor Steve said, “Truth is the bedrock of trust. To trust- is the ultimate freedom. Freedom- is the heart of love” Do you consider yourself as a person of truth? Explain why or why not.
6. Read Romans 8:28-40. How can this verse help us to daily put our trust in God, let go of the need to lie for fear and desire but live in the rhythm of truth which is the freedom received when placing WHOLE trust in God?
