### FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Have you or someone you know ever have a fear such as crossing a bridge, entering a small enclosed space, heights, spiders, etc. What is the fear and the reaction when facing it?
2. Have you ever been motivated to do something because of a fear tactic?
3. Pastor Cary said, “Fear is an emotion and an emotion is a physical response to a thought or event.” Is fear ever good? Explain.
4. Read Proverbs 1:7 and Job 28:28. What does “Fear of the Lord” mean?
5. Pastor Cary said, “It means to have respect and reverence for God...” Name an example of a misconception of Fear of the Lord. Give an example of Fear of the Lord in reverence. What is the difference?
6. Why should believers understand his or her fear? Read John 14:27 and Romans 8:15.

### FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away

***Fear Factor: The Bible tells us do not be afraid.***

Pastor Cary said, “The problem with fear is that it can cripple us...that is why it is so important to learn how to face our fears and deal with them.
