FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Since the fall of humanity, all are born and raised in this broken world where identities come from. According to John 1:1-13 what happens to all who believe in and accept Jesus Christ?
2. Pastor Steve said, “Our rebirth requires more than just being born again. It also requires, being raised again by your rightful parent-God.” What does being raised again and or reparented by God look like in your daily living?
3. Parents raising young children show them how to dress and behave according the parent’s standards. If one’s identity was of the world but is now of God through faith in Jesus, what may be the first step of reidentifying. Read Galatians 3:26-28.
4. How would you answer, what is your core identity?
5. Pastor Steve said, “Your core identity...is that you are a beloved child of God.” How can we clothe ourselves in Christ replacing any misplaced worldly attitudes about ourselves and take on the identity God has for us as His child? Read Ephesians 4:21-24
6. Pastor Steve said, “God didn’t need you He wanted you.” How can realizing God wants you and knows you as a loving parent help you to clothe yourself in Christ and be reparented by God to form His identity? Read Psalm 139:13-17.

FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away
