FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Read Acts 2:1-12. As the house was filled with a loud windstorm sound, people nearby came to see what was happening. Why were they amazed?
2. Believers filled with the Holy Spirit spoke a message that redemption was accomplished and applied through Jesus. Amazed that the message was spoken in different languages, the people questioned the meaning of it all. Read Acts 2:13-38. How did Peter answer their questions and doubts?
3. Pastor Carl Hart said, “The answer to the question (verse 12) has eternal impact.” How would you answer the question of someone witnessing the outpouring of the Holy Spirit?
4. The message and amazing fashion it was delivered in all languages meant the good news of the gospel was true and redemption was achieved. Who gave the speakers the ability to speak in unknown languages? Acts 2:4.
5. Jesus asked God to give His followers an advocate who will never leave and lead them in all truth. Who was the Advocate? Read John 14:16-17.
6. Read Acts 26:23. What was the truth that Paul shared?
7. Pastor Carl Hart said, “Every believer has personal power with God.” Read Acts 1:8. What does Jesus say we will do with the personal power God gives us in the gift of the Holy Spirit?

FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away
