### FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Read Mark 1:1-8. John the Baptist was a messenger of God to share the good news about Jesus the Messiah, Son of God. Who shared the message starting in Mark 1:14?
2. John the Baptist had a message with an external method to point people to the Good News. How was Jesus message the same but with an internal method to the Good News?
3. Pastor Steve said, "Jesus transformation is internal. The kingdom of God starts inside of you and then it works its way out..." The outward symbol of accepting Jesus is the water baptism to be cleansed on the outside. How does one receive cleansing on the inside to live the Good and Beautiful life Jesus calls His followers to do?
4. According to Jesus, where is the Kingdom of God? Read Luke 17:20-21.
5. Pastor Steve said, "A relationship with Jesus is internal". What would an internal relationship with Jesus look like compared to an external relationship with Jesus?
6. Read John 3:27-30. John the Baptist was a messenger of God to point others to the path of the Good News. What example did he provide us in verse 30 that we should live by?
