FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. The current condition of our world has the tragedy of murder and life ending disasters happening daily. Is this a new condition of our world or did the people of Jesus day experience similar events? Read Luke 13:1-4.
2. What was Jesus' response when he was told the tragic news of lives lost? Read Luke 13:1-5.
3. Pastor Steve said, "We are broken people and we live in a broken world." Read Genesis 1-3. What was God's original design for humanity and our world?
4. There is no difference in the one causing the tragedy than the one who suffers at the hand of the tragedy because we are all broken with sinfulness. In God's eyes all sin is equal. What then must we do? Luke 13:3.
5. Pastor Steve said, "Even though the world is not the way it was (perfect), and it is the way it is (broken), it can be different (redeemed). But that will take two things according to Jesus recognition and repentance." What does it mean to recognize and repent of sin? Romans 10:9-10.
6. In Luke 13:1-5 Jesus used the tragedies to show we are all in danger of God's judgement for sins consequences which is a bigger crisis with certain death eternally apart from God if we do not repent. What does Jesus illustration of the Fig Tree (Luke 13:6-9) show us about the time allowed for us to recognize and repent?

FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away

Gospel Gold- The wages of sin is death. We are all sinful. Death is certain. If we repent we can have eternity with God.

- ***Death is not the result of our "one" sin over another but our "state of being" broken – sinful ...living in a broken world -sinful***
- ***Genesis 1-2 ...what was God's original design... A good world with folks living in love and harmony***
- ***Genesis 3...the disobedience to God changes the world from God's original design of good, love, harmony to what we know now as evil, disaccord and hate. Now all are born sinners and live in a sinful world.***
- ***Romans 6:23 tells us there is a cost of sin but Jesus paid the price.***
- ***Luke 13:5 Jesus tells us unless we repent of our sins we will perish***
- ***John 3:16 tells us God sent Jesus to pay for our sins, once we repent and put our trust in Jesus we receive His gift of eternal life with God. Now we need to live for Him.***
