1: Read Proverbs 29:18

2: Read Proverbs 18:2

3: Read James 3:18

4: Read Galatians 6:7-8

5: Read John 3:30

6: Read Romans 14:17

FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. Does the law of consequences (cause and effect) apply to scripture? Read Proverbs 18:21, James 3:18, 2nd Corinthians 9:6.
2. Does the “cause and effect” scriptures mean, one can name what they want and claim in his or her faith to get that which is named in prayer by faith?
3. Pastor Steve said, “The Bible never promises...a one to one cause and effect. Blessings in the Bible is linked to God's pleasure in one's life. Woe in the Bible is linked to God's displeasure in one's life.” What would be an example from scripture of a “blessing & a woe”?
4. Can the consequences of (cause and effect) help one earn salvation?
5. Pastor Steve said, “As far as salvation is concerned, it is not something that can be earned. You don't have to measure up...because Christ took your punishment.” If the consequences are not about God's pleasure or displeasure regarding your salvation what is the benefits of God's blessings or woe's (cause and effect)?
6. God our heavenly Father discipline us like a parent training a child. What would be an example of an earthly blessing or effect linked to a spiritual cause like obedience to God?
7. Pastor Steve said, “The law of consequences is not a one for one law. When the Bible states that you can do all things through Christ who strengthens you, that does not mean that Christ does what you want. It means Christ will give you the strength to do what He wants.” Have you ever deluded yourself to believe scripture to fit your needs?

FOR THE INDIVIDUAL: Take Away

Freedom Rally Part II -Scripture point to physical benefits for spiritual behaviors – Cause and Effect

- *Blessings – God's pleasure in one's life - Woe's – God's displeasure in one's life.*
- *Freedom - to live faithfully & obedient to God then leave the blessings to God.*
 1. *If you are not a Christian- start with belief in Jesus- Hebrew 10:9-13*
 2. *If you are a Christian- ask the Holy Spirit where you are not in obedience to God*
 3. *If you are a Christian- regularly attend HCC – talk to God about your Freedom Seed giving*
