FOR THE GROUP: Working it out together

1. HCC method of achieving the mission of love is by balancing the five Biblical principles (Worship, Fellowship, Discipleship, Ministry and Evangelism). *Worship* is the people of God in a continual attitude of God, *Fellowship* is intentionally living life together, *Discipleship* is allowing God's Spirit to shape us as Christ lives through us, *Ministry* is not what we do but who we are. So, what is *Evangelism*?
2. Pastor Steve said, “Evangelism is simply loving others enough to introduce them to God.” What is the difference in learning about Jesus and becoming more like Jesus?
3. Read John 17:13-21. What makes evangelism important to becoming Christ-like and witnessing God's love?
4. Pastor Steve said, “If you know God's love for you, then you will surely love others enough to invite them to be loved by God.” Do you agree or disagree? Explain.
5. Is Evangelism for Pastors and Leaders in the church only? Why or why not?
6. Pastor Steve said, “This is your job as a Christian to invite people to know God...this is not an option” How does Jesus great commission for us show that evangelism is the job of every Christian?
