Guinness Cooking Rules

1. Open to 21 and over only
2. Cooking begins at 10:00am
3. Setup time is available from 8:00am – 9:30am. Teams must be checked in by 9:30am to be eligible.
4. Dish must be cooked on site, day of event.
5. GUINNESS will be providing the beer for your recipe.
6. There is no water supply at Parc, Teams must provide own water.
7. Cardboard must be placed under all cooking equipment. Team must supply cardboard.
8. Teams must provide a savory dish and all entries must utilize Guinness beer
9. No open/wood fires (propane may be used)
10. Teams should come fully self-sufficient. CBF will not provide cooking equipment, chairs, tables, etc. No electricity available for cooking teams on site.
11. Cook-off spots reserved at setup on first-come basis.
12. Each team must provide one 10x10 pop up tent. Tents not provided by festival.
13. Entry Fee: Amateur Fee is \$75.00 and includes a team up to 3 people
Professional Fee is \$150.00; pro teams have the opportunity to advertise their business (limit up to 3 people).
14. CBF will provide a small standard sample cup to each team. Your team can charge festival-goers \$1.00 per sample cup. This is to help off-set cost of ingredients/entry fees.

Judging

1. Collection begins at 4:00pm, with 5 teams' dishes accepted in 15 minutes. Your time slot will be designated and discussed with your team after check in closes. Time for announcement of winners will be at 5:00pm. Each team will be provided containers for their dish. Dishes not delivered to judging area on time will be disqualified.
2. Awards: A Grand Prize will be awarded for 1st place (to be announced in February).
A prize for 'Taster's Choice' (voted on by festival-goers) will be awarded.

General Info

1. All entry fees must be paid in full by Wednesday, March 8th in order to participate in the Cook-Off Event on Saturday March 11th. Any entries after this date will be subject to a late entry fee of \$25.00.
2. Your entry fee entitles you and two other people free admission for your cooking team. Your 3 wristbands for your cooking team will be given to you on morning of Festival in your packet when you check in.
3. No ice chest with beer or alcohol can be brought inside area. Alcoholic and Non-Alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase on day of event.
4. Each team is responsible for keeping their area clean by using trashcans provided. Bring own cardboard.
5. Please be sure to clean your area once the event is over.
6. Leftovers are the responsibility of the participating teams.

Bailey's Bake-Off

1. Entry Fee is \$10.00 (this does not provide free entry, admission must be paid separately).
2. This is our 'sweet' category. Dishes must be made ahead of time and utilize Bailey's Irish Cream (any flavor) in recipe.
3. Your dish must be delivered to cook-off tent by 2:00pm.
4. Announcement of winners will be at 4:00pm.
5. Awards: A Grand Prize will be awarded for 1st place (to be announced in February).
6. Since this competition is being baked 'at home' and not on site, we welcome all ages. But, those under 21 must have approval from an adult and supervision is recommended for young children.
