

## Gethsemane

Mt 26:36-46, Mk 14:32-42, Lk 22:39-46 (Jn 18:1)

## Mark 14

v.26 After singing psalms, they went out

Ps 118, esp v.6, 8-14, 17, 22-23

v.32 Sit here while I pray          moral support?

v.33 Only Peter, James and John join Jesus in prayer, then goes further in (v.35), leaving them

v.34 Tells them to “remain and stay awake”

v.36 take this cup from me, yet not as I will but as You will

v.41 are you still sleeping and resting?

Jesus says the urgency of the time (of His betrayal) dictates going, not resting

Eccl 3:1 there is a time for everything under the sun

Places where same word for rest is used:          **373 ἀναπαύω**

**Mt 11:28**          Take my yoke upon you, I will give you rest

**Mark 6:31** And He said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a secluded place and rest a while." (For there were many people coming and going, and they did not even have time to eat.

## **Luke 12:19**

NAS: years [*to come*]; take your ease, eat,

## **1 Corinthians 16:18**

NAS: *For they have refreshed* my spirit

## **2 Corinthians 7:13**

NAS: his spirit *has been refreshed* by you all.

## **Philemon 1:7**

NAS: of the saints *have been refreshed* through

## **Philemon 1:20**

NAS: from you in the Lord; *refresh* my heart

## **1 Peter 4:14**

NAS: of glory and of God *rests* on you.

## **Revelation 6:11**

NAS: and they (martyrs) were told *that they should rest* for a little

**Revelation 14:13** NAS: so *that they may rest* from their labors,

### **Application:**

1. How should the urgency of our times dictate how devoted we are to prayer daily?

2. How does being awake keep us from temptation?

See Eph 5:8-15

1 Thess 5:6 So then, let us not sleep as the others do, but let us remain awake and sober. **7** For those who sleep, sleep at night; and those who get drunk, get drunk at night. **8** But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and the helmet of our hope of salvation

3. Why does Jesus ask “let this cup pass from me, but...”

Rev 13:8 the plan of God was always the Lamb

also Gal 4:4, Is 53

KJV And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

HCSB All those who live on the earth will worship him, everyone whose name was not written from the foundation of the world in the book of life of the Lamb who was slaughtered.

Read all of Is 53

Jesus knew God’s plan, but was “swallowed up in sorrow, to the point of death”, Mark 14:34

Is 53:10 But the LORD was pleased To crush Him, putting Him to grief; If He would render Himself as a guilt offering, He will see His offspring, He will prolong His days, And the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand.

1 Sam 2:25 God was pleased to kill Eli’s evil sons

1 Sam 19:1 delight of David in Jonathan

Know the lengths our Savior went to for our redemption!

### **Application for whole “Miracles” series**

1. Know God has authority over all people, all situations, and all the elements of creation. He is greater than any afflicting Spirit or any disease.

Ex. Mk 4:39, 5:6-10, 25-34, 42, Mt 8:9

2. He tells us to pray, and to speak to our mountains

Ex. Mt 21:21-22

3. He tells us not to fear

Mt 8:26, Mk 4:39-40, 6:50

4. He tells us to trust the results when He is present
