

Importing Sequences with Multicam or Merged Clips

This table describes the best method for importing a segment of a sequence from another project that contains multicam or merged clips. If you are importing the entire sequence, or a sequence with standard clips, any method will work.

These methods apply to Premiere CC 2015 v9.0.2.

Clip Type	Is the media loaded in target project?	Recommended Method
Multicam clips	No	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the media browser, double-click your source sequence to open it 2. Split your timeline view by dragging your target sequence to the bottom panel 3. Highlight the clips you want to import 4. Drag them from your source sequence into your target sequence 5. Save and close your project 6. Re-open your project 7. Move the new clips to another bin and delete the Recovered Clips bin
	Multicam source clips only	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the media browser, double-click your source sequence to open it 2. Highlight all the clips you want to import 3. Select Edit > Copy 4. Open your target sequence 5. Select Edit > Paste

Merged clips	No	From the media browser, drag your source sequence into your target project
	Yes	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In the media browser, double-click your source sequence to open it 2. Split your timeline view by dragging your target sequence to the bottom panel 3. Highlight the clips you want 4. Drag them from your source sequence into your target sequence
