MISSISSIPPI • GOVERNOR POLL • OCTOBER 23, 2019

In the race for Governor, Lt. Gov. Tate Reeves (R) holds a 4-point lead (40% to 36%) over State Attorney General Jim Hood (D) among registered voters. The lead narrows to 3-points among likely voters. When undecided likely voters are pressed to make a choice (Leaners), Reeves is up 1 point (47% to 46%).

METHODOLOGY

The PollSmart MR online poll was conducted by Targoz Market Research, an independent research company with sample provided by Prodege, a leading market research panel.

Interviews were conducted from October 13, 2019 to October 20, 2019 among a sample of 549 respondents who live in Mississippi and are registered to vote.
