

Creative Science School Facebook Group Guidelines 2016-2017

The Creative Science School Facebook group is a closed group for current CSS parents, caregivers, teachers, and staff members. The group is not open to CSS students or alumni. All requests to join the group must be approved by a moderator, and those requesting to join may be asked to verify their current CSS status.

The CSS Facebook group is moderated. All posts must be approved by a moderator, though commenting on posts is open. (Inappropriate comments will be deleted.) If a post is not approved, the poster will be contacted by a moderator to explain why the post was disallowed and will be given information about how or whom to contact to resolve a concern. Moderators include multiple members of the communications committee, who are parent volunteers.

The purpose of the CSS Facebook group is for community members to share information and resources in a positive and collaborative manner. All posts must be school- or parenting-related.

Appropriate posts and comments include:

- Anything of interest to the community at large
- Announcements about events and activities happening at school
- Questions related to CSS (When is the...?, What is the...?, Have you seen my kid's...?, How do I find out about...?)
- Sharing information and resources that will make our kids' lives better (summer camps, book recommendations, a great park you discovered, etc.)
- Sharing parenting information and resources that will benefit our community
- Organizing a community play date or spontaneous get together

Inappropriate posts and comments include:

- Spam
- Promoting your business
- Selling anything or giving anything away that is not school- or child-related
- Individual dialogues (If you find yourself addressing only one member, it's time for a private conversation.)
- Disrespectful discourse of any kind, including disparaging remarks about other members of the community (students, parents, teachers, or staff)
- Confidential or sensitive information
- Anything in violation of the CSS Community Agreement

Members who violate the CSS Facebook Group Guidelines or CSS Community Agreement will be contacted by a moderator and given a warning and the opportunity to remove their post/comments. More than two violations/warnings will result in dismissal from the group.
